Xiaomi Mi 10 Update of February 14: Xiaomi announced a number of devices under the Mi 10 banner and this is the standard version of flagship. It comes with Android 10 based MIUI 11 out-of-the-box in its home country. Update from July 3: As of now, Chinese Mi 10 is getting treated with stable MIUI 12 upgrade bearing version number V12.0.1.0.QJBBCNXM, which is running through OTA for eligible users. The update should take some time to match on the device, but if you don't want to wait, here is where you get the new firmware link for a manual upgrade. Update of July 21: Mi 10 is now intercepting MIUI 12 upgrade bearing version number V12.0.1.0.QJBMIXM weighing to 1.0GB. It's an OTA update and thus it will take some time to intercept all variants. You can simply tap here to download MIUI 12 stable build on Mi 10 and manually flash it. Update of August 6: Xiaomi Mi 10 is part of the Android 11 beta program. It is now getting MIUI 12 beta stable update for its Russian units because its Chinese, European, and global variants have already upgraded to the latest MIUI 12 beta. The update carries the software version number V12.0.1.0.QJBRUXM and is released through OTA INTERMEDY, although users can still download the firmware and flash it on their Mi 10 (Russian) units by tapping here. from 7 August: Until Mi 10, Xiaomi had no special rum for Turkey. Cut so far, the Mi 10 has already received the 12th upgrade on its global, Russian, and European variants starting with China in the first place. [Source] Update of August 27: Last year, the Mi Note 10, which is a global equivalent of Mi CC9 Pro, received Android 10 first. Cut to now, Mi CC9 Pro (Chinese equivalent) has finally intercepted Android 11 Beta allowing users to test the new operating system on their Mi CC9 Pro devices. The update brings both Android 11 beta and MIUI 20.8.26 on board and reaches via OTA. [Source] Xiaomi Mi CC9e This is the lower or lite version of the standard Xiaomi Mi CC9. Mi CC9e comes with a 6.01-inch Super AMOLED display, SDM665 chipset, paired with 4GB/6GB RAM and 64GB/128GB internal storage options. Rear cameras, front cameras, battery and other features are similar to the Mi CC9. It also runs on Android 9 Pie with MIUI 10 and is expected to receive the Android 10 update by December 2019 or the first quarter of 2020. Update: Xiaomi recently pushed Android 10 based on MIUI 12 beta on Xiaomi Mi CC9e as part of the closed beta update in China. Now that the device has Android 10, it will shortly get Android 11 as well, although we are not aware of the timeline as of now, but stay tuned to get real-time information once available.
