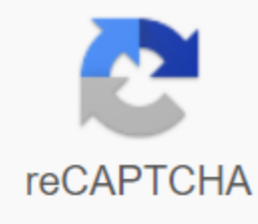

Infinite jeremy robinson synopsis

Infinite by Jeremy Robbins is best described as this, it's like Alice in Wonderland if Alice is a man trapped on a ship that travels faster than the speed of light and if Wonderland is the darkest part of human nature. The book opens with Will, our hero, stabbed in the chest and killed. Then everything became strange. As part of a distant future generation ship, Will and the rest of the crew are humanity's last desperate hope for survival. Their mission is to go to Cognata, an Earth-like planet orbiting a nearby star, and set up a new homeworld for our species. (It indicates we kinda fucked over the old) The thing is, one of the crew members went crazy, started killing and locked the ship's computer. Once Will recovers from his first death (the first of many) and conquers this nutbag, it's too late. He finds himself alone hurling through space at speeds close to light with nothing but the vastness of the universe to keep him company. And it's pointed out he is immortal which is why he tends to die so much. Infinite starts at the edge of the human experience and, from there, keeps going. The part I love most about this book is the story reveals in the kind of questions that leave me staring blank at my whiskey on a lonely night. What is conscious? What does it mean to be human? Is our species doomed by our own biology? What about AI, we're going to create a new non-organic life some day? What does that mean for organic life?! We can make a perfect computer simulation of reality?!? We live in a perfect computer simulation of reality?!?! What is REAL?!?!?! IS THERE ANYTHING REAL?!?!??? WHERE ARE MY PANTS!!! AND WHY DID I RUN OUT OF WHISKEY!!!! * Come out * The characters in this book, however, only have a few minutes to ponder unponderable before the shit comes down. Can we create AI? Oh shit, I did and it's trying to kill me! What if this is a simu ... RUN! The simulator is trying to kill me! Is the universe over? If you don't move you,, it'll end for you!! It's rare to have both of those jobs so well in a book. An initial theme I found interesting was the idea that our relationships in a community are inn compatible with collaboration and, therefore, survival. So on this generation ship towards a new planet, sexual partners are pre-arranged, sexual attraction to other crew members is grounds for dismissal and seats are indicated Randomly in the messy hall so that relationships cannot accidentally form. See, because relationships lead to loyalty. Loyalty divides the population into competing interests and we will only fight in dicks with Which, if you are at all aware of human nature.... Yes, we will absolutely do it. As the story continues, the topic evolves into something along the lines of 'what relationships are that make sense to our lives.' That... Have! Our lives are largely defined by our relationships. That's a big part of how we define ourselves and our place in this world. It's like taking the giant ball of shit away from the mani mani manoly beetle. Do it and what do you get? A small beetle upset. Just talking. I won't get this book hoping to walk with much hope for our species. As a fan of character-driven novels, something about this book has bothered me. The two protagonists feel like they've got their legs tied together and have been dragged through the desert by Horse Story. There are times when you can almost hear the characters say, I'll do this because the author needs me to move the plot of this book. This is a good idea. Also, I want a story horse. So early in our hero book the show an artificial intelligence that he then spins loosely on board. This snarky and slightly murderous AI quickly became my favorite character. Imagine if you put Mrs. Mabel in a computer then had it tried to kill you? Pretty close. This is one book that ends with a kind of... Meh... feel for me. Although it felt like it was considered a big reveal, I more or less saw it coming from about halfway into the book. And, without going much into it, I was very like... Oh... Ok. Yes. That makes sense. Is there any wine left? Okay, the real spoiler here. Seriously, skip to Number 10 if you don't want spoilers. Last chance! Suprise! It's all a simulation! All! The whole book! Okay, that's not entirely true. But that's not the weird part. Watching Gal AI is a bit of a frenzy that I said earlier was designed to help Will escape eternal nothingness by creating a virtual world for him. She proceeded to do this and, just so simulated take, proceeded royally fuck her shit up. But, in the end, it was revealed that she had loved him. That... I don't know. I almost have to read the whole book again to see if that makes any sense. And to quote SNARKY AI, Life is fun. Once you figure that out, you'll stop being like a sourpuss. As many of you know, the past year has been rife with personal challenges for me, including being told I had a brain tumor (it turns out I don't) and some kind of whacky chemical imbalance. Then, while my mind sorted itself out and I dealt with some strangely intense and out-of-control emotions, I finished writing the book.
