Apart from cleaning your pan or skillet after each use, seasoning cast iron ranks as the most important step you can take toward maintaining this type of kitchen. Spices are a simple process that leaves a natural nonstick coating, one that makes cooking with cast iron not only enjoyable, but also much more comfortable. How do you season cast iron? Continue reading to find out the steps involved! STEP 1 To start, preheat the oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit before washing the cast iron thoroughly. Use a combination of warm water and dish soap to remove any residue that has developed over time. Once done, rinse with water and dry pan or skillet with a soft cloth. In the future, remember that when cleaning cast iron, do not use dish soap, because soap reduces the effect of spices. After use, simply rinse the cast iron with water and wipe it with a kitchen cloth. Photo: shutterstock.comSTEP 2 Next, select the oil to use for your spices. Some experts say that refined flaxseed oil does the best job. This is far from the cheapest option, though. Crisco or fat works well, but really any vegetable oil will do as long as its smoke point, the temperature at which it starts to smoke is above your normal cooking temperature. First, make sure not to use any oil that boasts a strong taste. STEP 3 Pour into the oil of your choice, spreading it around to evenly coat the pan or skillet. For best results, rub your chosen oil with either a cloth or a paper towel. Cover every square inch of cooking surface. STEP 4 Place cast iron, upside down, in a heated oven, placing it on an oven rack with some aluminum foil underneath it. The goal here is to pan or skillet heat until the oil has reached its smoke point. Then and only then is the chemical reaction that causes the desired nonstick coating. Different oils have different smoke points. To flaxseed the oil to its smoke point, turn your oven to its maximum heat seating. If you use vegetable oil, keep it at 350 degrees. Bake the cast iron for about an hour, then turn off the heat and allow the metal to cool completely before removing. Additional tips After all, cast iron will have to be rusted again. To put that off for as long as possible, remember not to use dish soap when cleaning the kitchen. Simply rinse it with water, wiping it with a soft cloth instead of a sneering pad. If necessary, add a little salt to the scrubber power. When the cast iron surface becomes dull and sticky, you know that the time to season has come again. Bialik and Rauch support characters in the show. Women are reportedly each making \$425,000 an episode. Previously, women were only making \$175,000 per episode. This pay rise came after five stars of the show agreed to make \$100,000 per episode pay cut in 2017. Jim Parsons, Kaley Cuoco, Johnny Galecki, Kunal Nayyar and Simon Helberg waged before Bialik and Rauch's salary increases in 2017, each of the main cast members were making \$1 million per episode. With a small pay cut, they are each making \$900,000 per episode. Cast riches Throughout their time on the show, the cast of The Big Bang Theory have become some of the richest people on television. Galecki earned \$25 million between June 2017 and June 2018. His costars, Helberg and Nayyar, earned \$23.5 million. For four years in a row, Parsons earned \$26.5 million. During this period, Cuoco became the second highest paid actress on television, earning \$24.5 million. How does the cast feel about the show ending? While the cast is sad that the show is coming to an end, they seem to be happy with how things are wrapping up. I'm thrilled with [Penny's] ending, but at first, Cuoco told Entertainment Tonight. It's beautiful. There's nothing catastrophic, it's just beautiful. And the characters are going to live in your minds and in your hearts, and I think that's what's so special about it. It's really touching. The purpose of the final episode of the show was to give each character one last time in the spotlight. When we found out it was going to be last season, we sat together and started talking about landing space, executive producer Steve Holland told Variety. We knew what would be the last piece of the finale for a long time.
