The pressure pushes the electrons together called the tension and is measured in volts. For example, a generator spins at 1,000 rotations per minute can produce 1 amp at 6 volts. The 1 amp is the number of electrons moving (1 amp physically means that 6.24 x 10<sup>18</sup> electrons move through a wire every second), and the tension is the amount of pressure behind the electrons.
