The United States Customs and Border Protection Agency issues import licenses to businesses bringing physical goods into the country. Precise licensing requirements depend on the type of goods being imported. For example, you can only import petroleum products with the import authority, but food products require import licenses that are regulated by the Food and Drug Administration. Import duties are still charged on any item you've shipped in the U.S., even if no license is needed to obtain the item. If you import goods under the name of a company, request the employer identification number from the IRS. This will be the importer number that you will use on your license applications. If you will be working as a person, you can use your Social Security number as your importer number. You can also fill in US Customs and Border Protection Form 5106 to request a new importer number if you don't have a Social Security number or employer identification number. Buy a bailable bond if you are importing goods with a high dollar value. If there is a problem during shipment, bailable bonds act as insurance. Instead of losing the entire amount of your goods, you will only be out of the amount of bond premium. Make sure the bond limit is set high enough to cover the actual value of changing commodities. If it is not, you will still be responsible for any losses exceeding the amount of the bond. Contact consulates from shipping country to find out whether the country stands in good trade with the U.S. If it is not, you may not be eligible to apply for import licenses unless the issues between the countries are resolved. Even if the country remains in good condition, it can apply its requirements which you must meet before releasing the goods to your shipper. Decide on a port of entry for your goods. There are more than 300 ports of entry into the US that you can choose from. Import duty can be different for each port, so you may be able to save money by sending your goods to another location. Contact the appropriate regulatory agency for the type of goods you will import. There's no catch — all regulatory agency that handles all federal import licenses. You have to apply for an import license directly from the agency handling each type of goods. For example, if you wanted to import a food product, you would request a license from the Food and Drug Administration. You may also need a business permit from your city or county government. You take a retail licence with your State Government. Start with the website of the Taxation department or the Department of Revenue. In addition to the application instructions, the website is exempt from tax if the list of any retail businesses. When you take a retail license, you are registering as a sales-tax-paying business with the state. Depending on your state, it may be known as a seller's permit or certificate of registration. Whether you open a brick and mortar store, sell your home jewelry in flea markets or make your sale online, you need to get your retail license before you start selling. Some states also need retail licenses from companies selling services. You need a license for every state where you have a physical presence, such as a store or kiosk. If you make all your sales on the Internet, you may still need a retail license for the states you ship to. For example, South Carolina requires a license if you sell more than \$100,000 in goods or services there, even if it's all mail orders. If you sell in multiple locations, you may need a retail license for each store. When you research your state's retail license rules, don't forget to read any information about the exemptions. For example, in California, if you don't make at least three sales in 12 months, you don't need a seller's permit. Similarly, if you sell at flea markets a quarter bar in South Carolina, you may not need a retail license. States also offer special licensing for special cases, such as selling at trade fairs or selling in a temporary location for a month. Your state should have an online portal that you can use to apply for your license. It can also give you the option to print and download your application and then mail it. The specific information you need to provide includes: the name of the business. Mailing address and physical location. Your Social Security number and your federal employer ID number. All businesses in West Virginia need to register with the tax department to be considered legitimate businesses. This website includes all business license forms and applications for the state. Register with the website and fill out the online form. If your driver's license has been stripped in Georgia, you may be eligible for a limited driving permit, also known as hardship driver's license. The Georgia Department of Driver Services can eliminate its driving privileges through cancellation, repeal and suspension.
