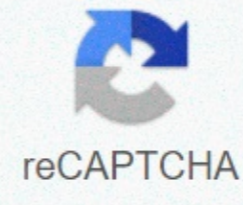

LISA Academy No or Little Scholars of Arkansas Academy – North Little Rock serves students in grades 12 and is administered by the LISA Academy School. LISA Academy North is a non-sectarian, non-discriminatory, tuition-free school funded by Arkansas State Board of Education. However, it is an example of many public school regulations so that it can pursue an innovative approach designed to improve students' performance. The first year of the school (2008-09) institution began with 8th-grade classes with an enrollment of over 300 students. It is operated by the LISA Foundation, which formed the first LISA Academy of Cocaine in 2004 as the state's first independent public school. Currently LISA North Academy has a K up to enrollment of 12th grade with more than 800 students. In August 2019 LISA North Academy will open a new building for 6th-12th year and existing LISA Northern buildings will use only elementary students. With more space LISA North Academy will host roughly 1000 students. Academics As an independent public school, LISA Academy North exceeds the Smart Core requirements developed by the Arkansas Education Department (ADE), which requires students to complete 22 credit units prior to graduation. Students are engaged in regular and advanced Placement (AP) work and exams, prep courses of ACT/SAT tests, leadership workshops, and partner with local colleges and universities. The school focuses on STEM (science, mathematics, engineering and technology) fields. Extracurricular activity LISA Academy North Mascot for academic and athletic teams is the Jaguar with red and white school colors. Club and Tradition LISA Academy North students participate in a variety of and organizations including future business leaders in America (FBLA), Robotics, PTLW, Math Kangaroo, League Math, Dance, Yoga, Taekwondo, National History Day National Honor Society, MathCounts, Quiz Bowl, Quiz Social Studies Bowls, Olympiad Studies, Olling Bee, and Student Council. LISA Academy has a tradition to involve parents through monthly activities. The most popular events are Muffins and Moms, Doughnuts and Dads, Cookies and Grandparents, Fall Festival, and Car Show. Home visits are also scheduled to staff based on the availability of the parents. Athletics LISA Academy of the North Jaguars participates in interscholastic activities at the 15 No Conference conferences provided by the Arkansas Activities Association. The Jaguars compete in volleyball, golf (boys/girls), basketball (boys), tennis (boys/girls) and soccer (boys/girls).
