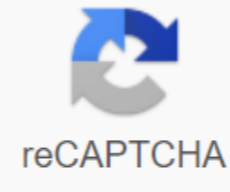

Negative informal commands worksheet answers

Links to contests, tests, etc. are on the left. In the previous lesson, you learned that commands are used when ordering or telling someone to do something. This is often referred to as the imperative form of the verb. Purchase (tu) el anillo. (You) Buy the ring. Scribe (you) the tarea. (You) Do your homework. Buy (you) the libros. (You) Buy the books. Come (you) potato. (You) Eat the potato. Remember that Spanish has a formal and informal style of discourse (tu/Ud.). This distinction applies to commands. Compre Ud. the anillo. Buy the ring. (formal) Buy (you) the dulces. Buy the candy. (family) Remember, formal discourse is generally used to be polite or to express respect. Informal or family speech is used among friends, co-workers, family members or when addressing a child. Informal affirmative commands (you) are formed in the same way as the current Ud indication. form: (hablar – ar + a = habla) (comer – er + e = come) (write – ir + e = escribe) Make sure that the commands you use the usted form. not the form you! The following examples of commands use three regular verbs: hablar, comer, and scribe. Habla (you) more slowly. (You) Talk more slowly. Come (you) the cena. (You) Eat dinner. I write (you) the letter. (You) Type the letter. Note that negative informal commands use the form of the current subjunctive. There are no cuentas tus beneficios. Don't count your blessings. There are many different types of commands in Spanish, including affirmative orders, formal orders, nosotros commands, indirect commands and negative tumult. Let's take a look at the commands you in this article. Don't be scared! (Don't be scared!) These command forms are not too difficult. Negative informal commands of overview, also called negative commands of you, are used to family member of the same age as you or minor, classmate, child or pet for not doing something. examples Do not buy the shirt. Don't buy your t-shirt. No aprendas español. Don't learn Spanish. Don't write the ensayo! Don't write the essay! Always be sure to put another negative word like nunca (never) before the verb when forming a negative informal order. The negative informal imperative, another term used to describe negative commands of you, is formed differently from the informal affirmative imperative. It actually forms a lot like the negative formal imperative, as it uses the current subjunctive form of the verb. If a verb is irregular in the current subjunctive, its negative informal command form maintains the same irregularity. examples Do not haga la tarea. Don't do your homework. There are no unfair seas. Don't be unfair. Placement of pronouns In negative informal commands, the pronoun goes between the negative word (of no or nunca) and the verb. examples Nunca les shopping dulces a los niños. Never buy candy for children. Nunca se los shopping.
