Omnipod freestyle meter error 4

I use freulance lite test strips with my PDM and about 1 out of 4 – 5 times I get an error declaring Meter Error 3 when I apply blood. Any suggestions? Am I doing something wrong? She always kind of did it. Becoming a waste of strips. Nick I see this problem too - and it's always linked to a time when for some reason, no matter how much blood I have to take for the strip, it doesn't respond. It always seems a time when trying to strip the left side of the strip – no idea what the malfunction is – but I only have about 1 in 25 error. I think it just has to do with the omnipod pdm. With a real meter for free style I never have the problem. I just got this error when I apply the blood before the PDM is ready for it. Or when I took too long to apply the blood and I wasn't paying attention and applied the blood a second after it goes into sleep mode (not knowing if it took the blood) then I turned it back on the use of the same strip and add more blood. I got this mistake with the flash meter – usually when some blood is on the strip and I have not noticed the meter is spun out. You've found it several times where no amount of blood seems to work as well. All of a sudden the last scale came like 5 errors – although previously it had 2-3 months to 5 errors. I love the butterfly strips – get so much less mistakes than the previous type. Well, I found out why. I tested to disappear quickly before the code number would disappear. This morning, my PDM gave me a critical error, disabled my pod, and displayed the 'call Omnipod' screen with the error reference code. The last time this happened, many years ago when I first had the first generation of PDM, that error meant that the PDM was dead, and Insulet gave me a new PDM overnight to replace it. Expecting the outcome this time, I got insulet, but they took me through a recovery process I didn't know anything about! On the back of the PDM, in the battery compartment, there is a small rectangular window just below the batteries where you can see the green circular map. In the middle of the map is a small hole. Using the end of a paperclip inserted into this hole repair the PDM (similar to getting a faulty pieping pod to stop pieping). I had to restore the PDM's watch, but all other institutions were unprovoked. I was so relieved that I didn't need to get a new PDM! Thought I'll share it, since I didn't see anything online about it. It.
