[2] Political career In parliament, Barrot is a member of the Finance Committee. [3] In this capacity, in 2018, he and Benedict Peyrol wrote draft legislation to combat large-scale tax evasion and avoidance schemes by stripping dividends in the wake of the Cumex files revelations. [4] In addition to his committee assignments, Barrot is a member of the Franco-Uruguayan parliamentary friendship group. [5] At the end of 2017, Barrot was appointed by President of the National Assembly François de Rugy as chairman of a 10-member working group on the reform of parliament. The group submitted two reports in 2017 and 2018, respectively. As of February 2018, Barrot was spokesperson for MoDem, together with Sarah El Hairy. In December 2018, he succeeded Yann Wehring as Secretary General of MoDem, led by the party chairman François Bayrou. After graduating from HEC Paris (Master Grande Ecole)[1] in 2007 and Sciences Po Paris (Master of Economic Governance)[2] in 2008, he obtained a master's degree in economics from the Paris School of Economics (2008) and a Doctorate in Finance from HEC Paris (2013). In 2013, he was appointed assistant professor of finance at the Sloan School of Management at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and an associate professor in 2017. In June 2017, he was elected as an MP for the second time. Jean-Noel Barrot is the winner of the Franco-American Foundation (promotion 2020). Political engagement Elected as departmental councillor of the canton of Yssingeaux in 2015 under the label MoDem and in collaboration with Madeleine Dubois. Jean-Noel Barrot is a candidate in the June 2017 parliamentary elections in the second constituency of Yvelines under the label La République en Marche!, after which he is elected as an MP with 58.3% of the vote. On 29 June 2017, he was elected Vice-Chairman of the Finance Committee. On 20 September 2017, François de Rugy, President of the National Assembly, announced his appointment as chairman of one of the working groups seeking to reform the institution. Entitled The Means of Control and Evaluation of Parliament,[7] this group consists of 10 Delegates from all political stripes, tasked with thinking about ways to strengthen the control and evaluation powers of the National Assembly. The Working Group submitted an initial report[8] to François de Rugy in December 2017 and a second report in June 2018[9]. In the latter, he presented François de Rugy with a roadmap for the creation of a permanent parliamentary evaluation office. On 28 June 2018 he organised the Spring of Evaluation in the National Assembly.[11] a day dedicated to the theme of the evaluation of public policy, including Esther Duflo and François de Rugy. On 13 February 2020, it will organise the Assessment Meetings[12] at the Hotel de Lassay, where more than 200 researchers, parliamentarians, administrators and citizens will meet on the same theme of the evaluation of government policy. In February 2018 he became spokesperson for MoDem, together with Sarah El Hairy. He succeeded Yann Wehring as General Secretary of Modem on December 12, 2018. To feed the Business Growth and Transformation Action Plan [or PACTE Bill][15] she presented a report on corporate finance to The Minister of Economy and Finance Bruno Le Maire, co-author of entrepreneur Alice Zagury, in December 2017. In July 2018, he was elected the theme rapporteur of the Pacte Bill, part of the text on corporate finance. In July 2019, he was elected rapporteur for the fact-finding mission on the implementation of laws. The goal is to follow the life of a law after its publication, focusing on all phases of its implementation to identify its strengths and weaknesses. In February 2020, he was elected rapporteur for the fact-finding mission on savings in a low-interest environment. The mission is aimed at analysing the economic determinants of falling rates and changes in savings behaviour, in particular those of households. After evaluating the public policies that have been pursued to adapt to this new environment, the mission is intended to propose ways of modernising savings policy in France. Jean-Noel Barrot will become Vice-President of the European Movement - France in April 2020. Research Jean-Noel Barrot obtained his PhD in 2012 after supporting a thesis in the financial economy under the leadership of David Thesmar at HEC Paris. In 2013, he was appointed assistant professor of finance at the Sloan School of Management at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). In 2018 he joins HEC Paris as associate professor. His research focuses on business finance and innovation, production networks and credit between companies, and the interaction between capital markets and markets for goods and services.
