Here we guide you through the process of downloading and deleting movies and shows from your Disney+ app. Discover Disney+ app Android phone, Disney+ offers a variable-quality feature that lets you sacrifice visual fidelity for a smaller digital footprint. Open the Disney+ app on your profile icon at the bottom right. From there, navigate to App Settings > Download Quality. You see options for standard, medium and high, the latter probably offer no more than 1080p resolution. Step 2: Download your content Because you can view any Disney+ title offline, no guesswork or filter is required to find downloadable content. The hardest part of this particular task is figuring out what you want to see. Once you've found out, all you have to do is tap the download button, which is right next to the Play button under the title's logo. For shows you will also find a separate download button next to each episode if you don't want the whole season. Disney takes care of the magic from there. It's a relatively quick download on Wi-Fi, especially at the lower qualities, so you'll probably have dozens of movies in those few hours before your flight if you forget to do it the night before. Step 3: Watch your downloaded movies and show everything left to do, enjoy yourself! An easy way to find your downloads is through The Download icon, which is always visible on the right side of the Disney+ app. All your content is listed here, sorted by the time you downloaded. Tap the play button on the thumbnail of whatever you want to see, and off you go. Episodes are listed slightly differently - they are under a single label, and tap on it will group all episodes you've downloaded for this show, grouped by season. You can also find these titles by searching and browsing regularly. You'll know that something is available for offline viewing when you see a smartphone icon that normally has the download button. How much space do I need? The amount of space each track eats is mainly based on video length and resolution, and because other variables are included in the equation—the largest is your quality setting—this number can vary greatly. We've downloaded three movies of similar length and resolution—some of the Star Wars movies, each showing just over two hours—to see how each of the options affects file size. The Empire Strikes Back at standard quality was 0.92 GB for a 2-hour, 7-minute runtime, while A New Hope at medium required 1.4 GB for 2 hours and 4 minutes. This is a modest leap compared to Return of the Jedi on high quality, which took 5.5GB for 2 hours and 14 minutes. For shows, a 39-minute episode of The Mandalorian on high quality lasts 1.5 GB, but only 270MB on standard and 424MB on medium. Finally, The Avengers: End Game requires a whopping 7.1 GB after a 3-hour, 1-minute runtime. Using the data above, you can create a rough estimate of the amount of disk space you need to store everything you want. You can mix and customize by adjusting your quality setting before you initiate the download. Now would also be an excellent time to set whether you need a Wi-Fi connection to download content, an option that should certainly be considered on limited data. By default, Disney+ only allows Wi-Fi downloads. What is available? As explained above, everything can be downloaded from the Disney+ catalog for offline consumption. Whether it's a whole season of Darkwing Duck or every single movie from the Marvel Cinematic Universe, if it's on Disney+, you can download it. Unlike some other services, Disney+ is pretty loose for restrictions. First of all, you can download a single title on up to 10 different devices at once, and you can download each of them as many times as you like. The only thing Disney asks is that you connect with Disney+ every 30 days. How do I delete titles? At some point, you want to make room for something new. Whether you want to delete a single title or a bunch at once, Disney+ makes the task wonderfully easy. Step 1: Delete a single title from your device, Process much easier than downloading files. In fact, it only takes a few seconds to delete something from Disney+. First, find a game of your content by going to the download area. You can access the download area by tapping the second icon on the right of the smartphone icon to the right of the title. Title. Remove download, and the title will escort itself directly from the memory of your smartphone. Deleting some selected movies or shows is an easy way to do so. Step 2: Delete all titles There are two easy ways to remove multiple at the same time. In the Edit Downloads section, select - at the top right of the screen. Multiple squares appear near your titles. Click a square to select the appropriate title. When you have selected all the titles you want to delete, select the Recycle Bin icon. You can also click the Select All button a second time, all titles will be unselected. If you're looking for an even faster solution for mass deletions, Disney+ offers it. You can tap your profile icon at the bottom right and click App Settings > Delete all downloads.
