Day, in astronomy, the average time between successive lunches. Noon is defined as the time when the sun is highest in the sky. Because the apparent movement of the sun is caused by the rotation of the earth, a day is therefore the length of time that the earth requires to return once to its axis in relation to the sun. In daily use, a day is equal to 24 hours. For astronomers, who use sidereal time (based on the movement of the earth relative to the stars), a day is 23 hours, 56 minutes, 4.09 seconds. The duration of the day gradually increases as the tides slow down the stake of the earth. In 100 years, a day will be about 1/1000 seconds longer than it is now. The word day is often used to mean the period of daylight between sunrise and sunset, so it is distinguished from the night when the sun is below the horizon. Near the Equator, this period of natural light is about 12 hours throughout the year. Elsewhere, days vary in length throughout the year, being longer in spring and summer, and shorter in autumn and winter. In the northern hemisphere, the longest day takes place around 21 June and the shortest day about 22 December. The day term can also mean any 24-hour period. In this respect, the Babylonian day began at sunrise, the Greek and Jewish day at sunset. Among the Egyptians and Romans, the day began at midnight. Our calendar day follows this system.
