Ab cell divisionThe process by which a cell, the parent cell, divides into two cells is called daughter cells. mitosis process in which the nucleus of a cell divides into two nuclei; each with the same number and type of chromosomes cytokinesisdivision of the cytoplasm chromatidone of a few strands of DNA that are part of a chromosome during meiosis or mitosis centromere region that joins two chromatids interphases of growth between two mitotic or meiotic divisions of a eukaryotic cell cell cycle repeating five-phase sequence of eukaryotic cell growth and division G1-phasea period in the cell cycle during the interphase, before mitosis .cytokinis and the S phase G2 phasea phase in the cell cycle, and is the final phase of interphase. It follows a successful completion of DNA synthesis and chromosomal replication in the S phase and occurs over a period - often four to five hours S phasehort for synthesis phase, is a period in the cell cycle during the interphase, between G1 phase and the G2 phase prophase mitosis in which chromosomes condense and become visible, the nuclear envelope breaks off and spindle fibres become visible metaphase of mitosis and meiosis when chromosomes move to and line up in the middle of a cell anaphase of cell division in which chromosome copies separate telophasestage of mitosis in which a new nuclear envelope forms and spindle fibres disappear spindle network of protein cables that form between separated centrioles and chromosomes move apart centriolea barrel shaped microtubules structure found in most animal cells, and cells of fungi and algae but not often in plants cyclic family of proteins involved in the progression of cells through the cell cycle. cancer class of diseases characterized by uncontrolled division of cells and the ability of these cells to invade other tissues, either through direct growth in adjacent tissue by invasion or by implantation in distant places by being transported through the bloodstream or lymphatic system.
