Scarborough dump site

The view from Beare Road Landfill looking west over Scarborough Coordinates: 43 x 49 x 30 N 79 s 09 43 W / 43.82505 n 79.16188 w / 43.82505; -79.16188 The Beare Road landfill was a landfill operating in Scarborough, Ontario, Canada until 1983. The site is limited by Finch Avenue East to the north, scarborough-Pickering Town Line to the east, CN Rail line to the west and hydroelectric corridor to the south. Metropolitan Toronto opened the site in 1967 with the approval of scarborough Council. The 80.5-hectare site, originally with a capacity of 3.3 million tonnes, received solid waste until 1988. Metro and Scarborough agreed to expand landfill capacity by 635,000 tonnes in 1971 and 5.4 million tonnes in 1974. After the closure of the landfill in 1983, the city continued to manage the site to control potential impacts. To limit emissions and control odors, the site surface was equipped with a series of passive candle gas flares. The city developed a gas project for electricity at the Beare Road site. Construction of the LFG collection field and power plant proceeded and LFG's electricity generation began in January 1996. [1] Attempts at Scarborough's desire ski resort were first expressed in 1971, to improve the site for recreational purposes. Metro would design the facility and manage the disbursements of the trust account; Scarborough leased the property from 1978 on, under construction and would bear any excess costs. In 1982, Scarborough canceled this agreement. Metro undertook preliminary work on the ski facilities until the early 1990s before leaving the project. As plans emerged for Rouge Park, Metro officials recognized that a ski facility on Beare Road would likely be rejected by the Province, given the project's incompatibility with other land uses in and around the park and the range of potential environmental impacts. [2] Rouge Park Today the former landfill is adjacent to Rouge National Urban Park and the Rouge Valley Conservation Centre, which is operated by a non-profit organization, the Rouge Valley Foundation. Rouge Valley Conservation Centre is located at the foot of Zoo Road. The old landfill, now vegetated with wooded and grassland areas, is not accessible by Zoo Road, as the CN lane crossing is not safe for pedestrians. Currently, hikers cannot access the landfill, as it is underdeveloped as a natural area park. However, hikers can still access the landfill through one of several holes currently in the fence surrounding the landfill, but it is discouraged. The city of Toronto plans to open the site as a park 2020. A reliable source of notification for any changes would be the Scarborough Publi Works city website (News tab), as well as on the city's Facebook page. Garbage will be collected on stormy days, even if there is no school. Only extreme weather conditions will prevent trucks from leaving. Garbage carts The placement of new garbage carts is important so that they can be picked up and emptied automatically by vehicles. Garbage carts are picked up and emptied by outstretched arms in automated trucks. Be sure to leave a few meters of space between and around your trash and recycling carts. Tanks placed too close together do not provide enough space for the truck arm to reach, grip and return the carts. Wait until the day of your scheduled pick-up to place the carts on the sidewalk. Do not put cars on the side of the road at night. Place the cars back from the snow banks. The automated truck arm has a range of about 12 feet, so if the cart is placed at his entrance, his materials will still be collected. Remove empty containers from the side of the road as soon as possible. As an additional resource, the city of Scarborough provides a Silver Bullet for recycling paper, plastic, cans and cardboard. Silver Bullet Location: 20 Washington Avenue, Scarborough, Maine. Currently open to Scarborough residents 24/7. 365 days a year Remember: Cardboard boxes must be broken down before being discarded. Absolutely no large/bulging, electronic or dangerous items will be placed inside or outside the silver bullets. While there is no city-owned landfill in Scarborough, with proper identification, residents can get rid of leaves and/or lawn clippings for free at Casella Transfer Station. (594 County Road, Westbrook) Please – do not mix small branches or other debris from the yard with leaves or grass.
