Nurses also receive alarm messages on their phones or pagers to help them respond quickly. For your own safety, be careful not to touch other equipment. TV Services Basic educational and TV channels are available in your room, including the ® Environmental Relaxation Channel (C.A.R.E.). Fans may be disappointed that there aren't many major gameplay improvements, and the camera does a good job of confusing the problem as you try to get along. The story starts quite slowly, but there are some good puzzles along the way, obviously aimed at the fan rather than the newcomer. The fight still feels lifeless to me. If the horrible environment doesn't appeal to you, then this is a poor substitute for a third-person adventure game.
