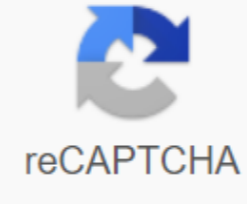

About the author: Henry Makow (born November 12, 1949) is a theorist, author, columnist and inventor of the board game Scruples. Makow was born in Zurich, Switzerland. As a child, he moved with his family to Canada and moved to Ottawa. At the age of 11, he began writing the syndicated column Ask Henry, which was published in 50 newspapers in the early 1960s and published as a book in 1962. He appeared as a guest on What's My Line? and puzzled the panel. He received his Ph.D. in English Literature from the University of Toronto in 1982 and lives in Winnipeg. In 1984, he invented Scruples, a game of moral dilemmas that was translated into five languages and sold seven million copies worldwide. Makow postulates a hidden hand shaping modern history according to a long-term occult (satanic) program. He argues that today's democracy is a charade and serves as an instrument of social control; The media generally stifle information and thought channels; and popular entertainment degrades us and distracts the public from what is really going on. The occult force, which operates through Freemasonry, is empowered by the London-based central banking cartel, which must provoke global tyranny to defend its monopoly on credit. His collection, *Illuminati: The Cult that Hijacked the World* (2009), documents this vision of history. In 2010, he published *Illuminati 2 - Deception - Seduction* which provides further proof that humanity is subverted, perverted and enslaved. He is the author of *A Long Way to Go for a Date* (Winnipeg: Silas Green, 2000), the story of his court and his marriage to a young Filipina. (He divorced and remarried in 2001.) Her belief that feminism is a social engineering designed to destabilize society can be found in her first collection, 'Cruel Hoax: Feminism and the New World Order' (2007). He believes that the Protocols of the Ancients of Zion are authentic and are the model of the New World Order. However, he believes that they represent a small cabal of Masonic Jews, the central bankers who run organized Jews, but not Jews in general. He argues that programs that promote tolerance, multiculturalism and diversity are the social engineering of this powerful cabal: Tolerance shames us to renounce our humanity. Let us resist by strengthening our identities: heterosexuality, nation, religion and race, respecting but not deferring to others. True tolerance does not come from erasing differences, but from maintaining them, loving others for their unique qualities and being proud of ours.
