In her films, Little engages in violent and extreme sexual acts with female performers, the DOJ said in a press release. A former IT worker has been sentenced to one year and a day in prison for stealing sensitive information belonging to his associates and using data to make money by completing online health surveys. Cam Giang, 31, was fired from the University of California San Francisco Medical Center earlier this year after investigators found he used the names, birthdays and Social Security numbers of other UCSF employees to fill out hundreds of online surveys. The point was to collect online vouchers, worth 100 US dollars each. He worked in the medical center's IT department for five years and had access to sensitive information through his job, according to court records. Between January and April of this year, Giang filled out 382 surveys before the company that paid for them, StayWell, realised what was happening. StayWell offered UC employees gift certificates as incentives to fill health surveys, but that became wise to defraud. The company received complaints from employees who could not complete the surveys on their names. In court filings, Giango's attorney said he received 218 vouchers (with a total value of \$21,800) but never managed to cash them in. Giang used only a fraction of his associates' Social Security numbers while filling out the survey, his lawyer said in a memorandum of punishment. Mr. Giang never intended to steal their identities, and apart from losing his chance. In StayWell's marketing research, the victims lost nothing, according to Oct. A 23-year-old German man has been sentenced to seven years in prison for online fraud with fake web shops that caused & amp;#172;\$1.1 million (1.36 million U.S. dollars) in damage, a spokeswoman for augsburg's lower regional court said on Tuesday. Authorities believe the man, who is from Essen, is leading gang fraudsters who ran a network of 187 fake online stores, said Matthias Nickolai, a spokesman for the Augsburg public prosecutor's office. He himself, of course, denied that he was the leader, Nickolai added. Shops sold goods such as electronic equipment, household appliances and precious metals, among other things, he said. Customers never received the items they ordered and during the operation of the stores sold goods in 2,054 known cases, Nickolai said, citing the indictment. The gang operated between November #172 2008 and January 2009. The gang used a phishing email to tell the victims that a computer virus had compromised their accounts. These emails led victims to a fake website that appeared to be a legitimate bank page to obtain an account and other personal information from the victims, according to the German public prosecutor. The suspected gang leader was arrested in May 2011. Three other cybercrime gang members were arrested and the court had previously heard their cases. Another man was sentenced to four years in prison, while another man received a two-year suspended sentence. The arrested woman also received a suspended sentence of one year and six months. Other gang in another way, were also prosecuted and given fines or suspended prison sentences. There are still cases of alleged gang members pending in court, he said. One of the 19 prime suspects was found not guilty, Added. A man convicted on Tuesday can appeal the verdict to Germany's Federal Court of Justice and then the European Court of Human Rights if he loses a federal appeal, Nickolai said.
