A negative result may mean that you are not pregnant, or that you took a test too early for the pregnancy hormone to be detected by the test you used. What I need to know before starting the test First find the right pregnancy test for you. Then, there are a few things you should do before taking a pregnancy test, like: Check the expiration date on the field. Even if you recently purchased a test, it's always a good idea to make sure that the test you purchased is still valid. An expired test can produce an unexpected result. Use the first urine during the day if you test early. Pregnancy tests look for the presence of the human chorio gonadotropin hormone (hCG) in the urine, which is more concentrated first thing in the morning. If you haven't missed a period yet, your hCG levels may not be high enough to be detected in more diluted urine. However, you can test at any time of the day if you've missed a period, as pregnancy hormone levels will be high enough to give a positive result at any time of the day if you're pregnant. Do not drink too much liquid before the test. How much to drink before the test is especially important if you are testing early on how too much fluid can dilute the level of hCG in your urine. Decide how to test. If you want to collect a sample, have a clean cup to hand you can use. If you decide to test directly in the urine stream, make sure you have the test ready for use. You can use a timer. Track the time it takes to reading the results can help make sure you wait long enough. It's one thing to prepare a test, but you may also want to prepare for the results. Know your options if you don't want to be pregnant – there's no help out there for you if you have a positive result and you're hoping the test comes out negative. If you are trying for a child and you get a negative result, do not worry about it - it is possible that you did the test too early (if this is the date you expect from the period), so you can try to perform another test a few days later. Even if the result is negative, you can increase your chances of conceiving next month by using an ovulation test to know when the most fertile days are. If you're worried about results, know that you have options no matter what you choose. How to use the Clearblue pregnancy test: Step-by-step guide: Remove the test stick from the package and remove the cap. Place the tip absorbed in the urine stream for 5 seconds. Or, if you prefer, immerse yourself in a urine sample collected in a clean, dry container for 5 or 20 seconds, depending on the test you are using. Keep the absorbent tip downwards throughout the testing process – do not turn the stick with the absorbent tip facing up. Put on the cap and lay the stick flat. Wait 1 – 3 minutes according to the instructions of the test you are using. Read the results. In the instruction leaflet you will find how to interpret the result and any subsequent steps to follow How long should I wait for the result? How long it takes to get results when using a pregnancy test at home depends on your brand and test. All Clearblue pregnancy tests have a waiting time of 3 minutes or less. Some tests also take anxiety from this waiting period by offering a countdown, or you can try our quick detection test, which can give you a positive result as soon as 1 minute if you are testing from the day you missed the period, however, wait 3 minutes to confirm the negative result. How to read the pregnancy test After taking the test and waiting for the results, it's time to understand them. If you want to know how to do a pregnancy test at home, first check the instructions for the test, but you can also read about the positive test results and their significance. A digital pregnancy test will spell your result, usually with words like Pregnant or Not Pregnant, while other tests will show you two lines or a positive symbol to confirm a positive result. Use the test right away. It is enough to hold the tip of the change of the absorbent dye facing down in the urine stream or in a urine sample, in a clean, dry container, for only 5 seconds. The tip of the color change will immediately turn pink, showing that urine is absorbed. Continue holding the tip of the color change in the urine for a full 5 seconds. IMPORTANT Keep the color change tip facing down or put the pregnancy test stick flat while waiting for the result. As the pregnancy test begins to work, you will see blue lines begin to develop. The result can be read in the results window. The blue line must be present in the control window when reading the result. This line shows that the test worked. The result in pregnancy may appear within 1 minute during the test from the day of omission of the period (that is, the day after the expected period). Wait a full 3 minutes to confirm the result Not pregnant or during the test before skipping the period (see question 10). If a blue line does not appear in the control window within 10 minutes, the test did not work. It does not matter if one of the lines that make up the + symbol is lighter or darker than the other; the result is pregnancy. Read your score within 10 minutes of the test. After this time, ignore any changes to the result. In laboratory tests with early pregnancy samples Clearblue reported the following results: Number of days before the expected period -1 -2 -3 -4 % of samples from pregnant women giving a result In pregnancy 98 % 97 % 88 % 56 % To be taken, when the period is due, calculate the usual cycle length, counting the number of days from the first day of the period to the day before the start of the next period if you have irregular cycles, you should allow the longest cycle in the last months before the test. If you have no idea when your period is due, we recommend testing no less than 19 days after the last time you had unprotected sex. If testing from the date on which the period is due, you can test any time of day. If the test is early, use the first urine during the day. Avoid excessive fluid intake before testing. If the result is not pregnant, and pregnancy is still suspected, refer to question 9. When you are pregnant your body produces the pregnancy hormone hCG (human chorio gonadotropin). The amount of hCG in the body increases in the early stages of pregnancy. Clearblue Rapid Detection can detect small amounts of this hormone in the urine. (The sensitivity of this test is 25mIU/ml.) • Always read the manufacturer's instructions for any medicines you are taking before performing the test. • Fertility medicines containing hCG can give misleading results (these fertility medicines are usually given by injection and a test too soon after administration may give a false result during pregnancy). • Other fertility therapies (such as clomiphene citrate), painkillers and hormonal contraceptives (e.g. birth control pills) should not affect the outcome. • If you have recently stopped using hormonal contraception or fertility therapies such as clomiphene citrate, periods may be irregular, leading to too short a study. • If you have recently been pregnant (even if you have not been transported to the full period), you may get a false pregnancy result. • Ectopic pregnancy, ovarian cysts, menopause and some very rare diseases can give confusing results. If you receive unexpected results you should discuss them with your doctor. While the clearblue rapid detection pregnancy test is more than 99% accurate in detecting the pregnancy hormone from the day of the expected period, it is possible to get a result during pregnancy and find out later that you are not pregnant (i.e., you may later get a result not pregnant, or the period may begin). This can be due to natural loss in the early stages of pregnancy, known as early pregnancy loss, which is unfortunately not uncommon, as about 1 in 4 pregnancies end up losing their pregnancies early. The appearance of the + symbol in the resulting window may vary, however, the lines that make up the + symbol and the line in the control window should be of a similar width (see photos A-C). • For the result to be Not pregnant, the control window must have a blue line and a - (minus) symbol in the resulting window within 10 minutes of the test. If the result is not pregnant and pregnancy is still suspected, refer to question 8. You may not be pregnant or your pregnancy hormone levels may not be high enough to be detected yet, or you may have miscalculated the day of the expected period. • If you have tested before, please check again when your period expires. • If the period is late, test again in 3 days. If this test gives a result not pregnant and still did not have a period, you should contact your doctor. If the test says you are pregnant, you should contact a doctor who can advise you on what steps to take next. The result in pregnancy can appear within 1 minute during the study from the day you miss the period (that is, the day after the expected period, but did not come). Make sure that the blue line is also present in the control window before reading the result. You should wait 3 minutes to confirm the result not pregnant or during the test before you expect your period. If a blue line does not appear in the control window within 10 minutes, the test has not been worked out (see question 6).
