It was led by his first full-time director, Harold Mace. In the early 1970s, the FPP (publisher of Redbooks) and OSU Fire Service Training separated from the Center for Fire Protection Studies and became two cooperation entities. Today, the FPP operates from an enlarged new office building and a warehouse distribution centre in the northwestern part of the OSU campus.
