
Parrot ck3100 pairing





When you first connect to a power supply, the hands-free kit must be combined with your phone. First, turn on Bluetooth on your mobile phone scanning for devices. Once detected, parrot CK3100. Once the pairing is successfully completed, the Pairing Completed option will appear on the screen. Parrot CK3100 will then connect to your phone. This is a common problem faced by many iPhone users. First of all, make sure you have Bluetooth turned on. Go to Settings > Bluetooth. If you don't turn on or display a rotating tool, restart your device and try again. If this doesn't work, other headphones may be connected to your device. You may see the error message Cannot pair with Parrot CK3100. Cheers It's a common internet myth that you can just reset the CK3100 by holding down the red and green buttons (according to the Reasons for the need to reset: A. If you go to Settings / Device Pairs and you already have 5 phones on the list. This means you can't add a new phone until 1 or more are deleted. B. The kit behaves strangely with your phone - there may be several reasons for this. Since there is no special reset function you can achieve this in one of 3 ways: 1. Go to settings / Bluetooth / Device pairs and click on a phone you want to remove. Press the center button and scroll down to delete, then press the GREEN button to confirm the deletion. Repeat this procedure to remove all pairs of phones that are not required. 2. Re-expense CK3100 with the latest Parrot firmware (V5.00c). The CK3100 can either flash again with a USB update cable (which we provide) or you can reschedule it via a Bluetooth connection with the Parrot update tool. The reprogramming will remove all paired phones. 3. Remove power from the CK3100 by disconnecting the control box for 5 to 10 minutes (to allow capacitors to be fully discharged). This will not remove the paired phones, but will allow the CK3100 to start from a known situation. You still need to remove any pairs of phones manually. Alternatively... 1. Get the installation defect corrected by the original installer, since they incorrectly installed it to begin with. Or two. Locate ck3100 control box power lead. Red lead should be permanent 12V and orange lead is only 12V when ignition is turned on. If power feeds are the wrong way around simply undo the tops of red and orange fusersholders and swoop on each other. Then you will have a red cable that goes to one side of the fuse and an orange that comes out on the other side. (If you lose security(s) it's a 20mm 5A slow blow type). Finally, unplug the 4-pin power plug from the Parrot CK3100 for about a minute to discharge the capacitors. Apply power once again and check that you can assign a phone and that when you turn off the ignition of the CK3100 shows Good Bye and closes after a few seconds. Please note that if you have not paired a phone with the CK3100 you can only see the message Goodbye for a very short time. The only downside to this of course, is when you upgrade your phone that can't find the car kit.
