He co-founded the Ministry of Loving Hands and is active with the Ministry of Pregnancy Resources. He was Gideon. In 2016, the Evangelism Foundation recognized him as the Harry Denman Evangelism Award. The Douglas County Chamber of Commerce and Industry recognized him as the Citizen of the Year Award for 2015. He loved being involved in church and church service, especially seeing Jesus change lives in preparation for Heaven. Gary loved watching sporting events, especially when his children and grandchildren were involved, along with Auburn Football. Family time was a high priority for him. Seeing how much each of them enjoyed being together, loving each other and knowing everything was fine with them.
