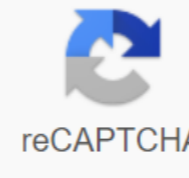

Montana driver manual

Review montana statutes require an adult kindergarten license through the Department of Health and Human Services. Licensing regulations are described in this profile. The Department of Health and Human Services provides adult day care as part of waiving physically disabled and elderly people and waiving developmental disabilities through licensed providers. Licensing and certification requirements of the Definition Of Adult Kindergarten means a facility, freestanding or associated with another medical institution, which provides adults, according to a regular schedule, with the care necessary to meet the needs of everyday life but which does not provide care overnight. These included achievement and renewal awards for practitioners, professional development incentive awards and scholarships for assessing child development associates, and accreditation through the National Association for The Upbringing of Young Children or the National Association for Family Childcare.
