Are you ready to join pup leagues of isko and iska? Then you must first prepare for pupcet! Polytechnic University of the Philippines College Entrance Test (PUPCET) manages the annual PUP for up-to-date graduates. It usually runs from August to October. All PUPCET candidates must apply online using the university's iApply website. An important reminder: You must seriously review and prepare the pupa, as each admission candidate is allowed to apply and take the exam on only one campus, and only once in an academic year. Here's a comprehensive guide on taking PUPCET: Eligibility to qualify for PUPCET, you must be any of the following: a grade 12 student who is expected to graduate at the end of the academic year K-12 graduate student who did not enroll in any technical, graduate or graduate study immediately after graduating with GWA of 82% or more. A passer-by of the Philippine Educational Placement Test (PEPT). It must have the right to enroll in a college with an average score of 82% or higher in its 5 subject areas: mathematics, communication arts (English), science, communication arts (Filipino) and Araling Panlipunan. A passer-by of the Alternative Learning and Equivalence System (ALS) Test for Secondary Level. Must be eligible to enroll in college: with Percentile Correct (PC) 82% or more and has 100 or more standard score (SS) with writing essays of 82% or more following DepEd regulations. He graduated high school in 2016 or earlier in the year, but did not enroll in any technical, diploma or graduate studies at any school. Requests Before you can apply, you must obtain this list of requests. Be sure to keep your 2×2-inch colored photo with a name tag, saved as JPEG format (.jpg or .jpeg). The file size must not exceed 300 kilobytes. Original or certified true copy of the high school card (P138) with school dry seal Certified certificate of non-enrolment for high school graduates who did not enter any technical/ graduate/graduate program immediately after the completion of high school Certificate of completion for senior high school Original PSA birth certificate Certification of good morals issued by a senior secondary school principal or guidance counselor with school dry seal Neatly certified copy of PEPT/ALS A&E test certificate. Certified by DepEd-NETRC-BALS School ID (for currently enrolled students) or any valid ID with a picture (for previous graduates) To sign up online, go to PUP iApply for PUPCET. Read the service agreement and click the Read button to start the application. Fill out the application form and click the following. Make sure you have read and respond to the information you need correctly. The name and date of birth must be the same listed in your NSO birth certificate copy. The e-mail address you will find should be active and correct. After you have completed the form, read the service agreement and check the Yes check box, I have read and understood. Then type the full name in the Digital Signature, and type the characters in the Digital Security Code. Click Make changes if you need to make the necessary changes or Next to finally submit your data. After you submit your registration, allow five (5) business days before requesting your ePermit. Remember to write down the reference number. To download your ePermit, go to PUP iApply and click request ePermit. Enter the necessary information and send it. After clicking Send, you'll see any of the following messages from the system: Successful app - If you see this message, click Download ePermit. Click Save or Open when your browser asks you. This will take over your ePermit. Print your color ePermit. The composition of the PUPCET exam consists of 150-200 cases. Like any other entrance exam at the university, each subject will be limited time for each subject, so make sure you wisely manage your time. Exam coverage includes: mathematics – Algebra, quantitative reasoning and basic math English – spelling, verbal reasoning, understanding of reading and grammar. Science – Biology, Physics, Chemistry Results List of Successful PUPCET Exams is published on the University's website from March to April. Each PUP campus comforts a specific date to show a list of passers-by. Confirmation of slots and application schedules is done through the university's website. Failure to add an appointment may result in you cancelling your university enrollment, so be sure to visit the website regularly.
