Its sister, Mary Lule Averbeka, described the transition to Anderson County decades ago. Mercy Health – Anderson Hospital celebrated its 30th anniversary. Originally called Our Lady of Mercy Hospital in Anderson, the hospital opened its doors in August 1984. At the time it was the extension of Our Lady of Mercy Hospital in Mariemont.Both sites were managed by university nurses. We were built into the hillside, said Averbeck, who is currently on a mission Anderson Hospital, which was chaplain at the Mariemont facility in 1983. We needed to expand (and) began to think that we had to do something east. The sisters of charity began planning a transition to a 44-hectare site at Anderson Buoy.Sister Marjorie Bosse, former head of the Charity Hospital, recalled how smoothly the transition to Anderson progressed. The most exciting part was being in a new facility where you could implement new technologies to provide quality care to people in the community, she said. Construction of Anderson Hospital began in 1982. When Our Lady of Mercy's Anderson was opened in 1984, it originally had 96 beds. This was about one-third of the current size, said Averbeck.Within five years the obstetrics department and full-service lab were added. The room was quite small and the bathroom was quite small. At the time of the move, the world got bigger, Averbeck said, adding that staff served at both Mariemont and Anderson locations. It was really exciting, but difficult because it was a division that was beloved in Mariemont Hospital, said Averbeck.The Mariemont Hospital, which was originally opened in 1942, continued operations for several years after anderson's facility opened. Although the Mariemont authority ceased to operate as a hospital in 1989, it serves as the oldest standard of living. Mercy Hospital Anderson has experienced significant expansion throughout the years, including the addition of two Medical Arts buildings. The first Medical Arts Building opened in October 1984, while the second opened in 2007/2008.Mercy HealthPlex was built across the street from the main facility in July 1998. Mercy Hospital Anderson became Mercy Health – Anderson Hospital in 2011.Mercy Health-Anderson Hospital is currently in the midst of one of its largest construction projects. After repairs to the main facilities and parking lots, the main building will be expanded to 150,000 square feet. With expansion, all patients will have private rooms. Bosse said with the move to Anderson's place, we were able to focus on a wellness approach and more fully engage the community in hospital operations. It (is) the most rewarding experience in this community, she said. Averbeck said 30 years later, the goal of starting a hospital is still just as relevant. It is an expression of our mission (which) takes care of people, putting emphasis on the poor or uderserved, she said. The sisters are very proud. Proud.
