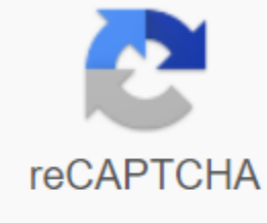

Later, the Spanish GED version was also authorized for use in other parts of the US. The writing section in Spanish is qualified by evaluators who speak Spanish as the first language or by teachers who are having at least one university degree in Spanish. Students who wish to take the GED exam in Spanish may also be required to take an ESL test (English as a second language). Not all test centres offer Spanish GED, so please contact your local GED testing centres for details. One more point of concern is that GED officials are sometimes unaware of immigration status requirements. In most states, no social security, and holding a suitable photo-IDD is sufficient. Then again, there are states that have a different interpretation of the regulations. So please be informed to avoid disappointment. I want to know if an illegal person can get and apply for their GED here in the U.S. and specifically in the state of New Jersey? A. So we know you can. It seems that the only states where a Social Security number is needed are South Carolina and South Dakota, although we have some doubts about that is really so. So keep in mind that, generally speaking, everyone can take the GED if they meet the requirements. Legal or undocumented does not matter, but valid IDs and in many states require proof of residence. Learn more about your status here. So again, it seems that some states (some testers say South Carolina and South Dakota) require applicants to have a Social Security number. However, what South Carolina students might well do is take the GED to North Carolina. This state does not ask for residency tests. Then again, according to the website, all south Carolina test candidates must provide proof of South Carolina residency, a valid image ID, and a Social Security number or a green card number or a federal tax ID number at the test center on the day of the trial. And the South Dakota website says: At the time of a GED testing session, candidates must provide valid government-issued IDs (national or international) that include name, photograph, date of birth and signature.
