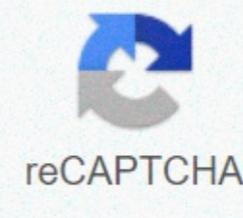

Additional approvals if food is to be sold is required together with the application: physical description of the applicant, proof of identity and address, together with two (2) pictures, not less than two (2) inches, nor more than three (3) inch square. A brief description of what will be sold and whether it is produced, grown, produced, produced or assembled by the applicant.
