Google Docs allows you to share documents with co-workers, business contacts and friends, and gives them the ability to view and edit content on their own computers or smartphones. Saving a Microsoft Word document to Google Docs involves little more than signing in to your Google Docs account and uploading the document directly from your computer's desktop or storage folder. Open your web browser and go to the Google Docs website (see Resources). Enter your Google Docs username and password and click Sign In. Click the Stay Connected check box if you do not want to enter your login details each time you upload or access a document. Click Docs List on the Google Docs menu, and then click the Upload button. Click Browse. Select the Microsoft Word document that you want to upload from your computer. Click Open followed by Upload. Unfortunately, you can't export a document as JPEG, but there are a few other simple solutions. Here are a few. Convert a single page to JPEG If you have a Word document that is just a page or if you want to capture only a specific page from a longer document, then you can use screenshot software like Snip & Sketch for Windows or Mac's Screenshot app. RELATED: What is the difference between JPG, PNG and GIF? The first thing you'll want to do is zoom out of the Word document so that the entire page is visible on the screen. You can do this by adjusting the zoom slider on the status bar to the minus symbol. There is no exact recommendation about the percentage, just make sure that the entire document is visible. With the page fully visible, type Snip & Sketch in the Windows search bar. Open the Snip & Sketch tool, then select New or press Cmd+Shift+4 on Mac to open the Screenshot app. Crosshairs will appear on the screen. Click and drag the scope to capture the entire page of the Word document. Then, if you are using Snip & Sketch on Windows, select the floppy disk icon to save the image. Mac users will select File > Export. Name the image and select JPEG from the list of file types. Finally, click Save. Convert to PDF and then TO JPEG in Windows As mentioned above, you cannot convert a doc file directly to JPEG. However, you can convert your Word document to PDF and then to JPEG. RELATED: What is a PDF file (and how do I open one)? To convert a Word document to PDF, open the document and select the File tab. Then select Save As in the left pane, and then select Browse. In File Explorer, choose the location where you want to store the file and name it. Select the arrow next to Save as type and choose PDF from the drop-down list. Now your file is saved as a PDF. RELATED: How to convert a PDF to a Microsoft Word document To convert your PDF to JPEG, you will need to download the free conversion software from Microsoft. Open the Microsoft Store app and enter PDF to JPEG in the search bar. Select the first option. The following page displays information about the software. Read through it, and then select Get. The software will be installed automatically. Open and click Select File near the top of the window. Browse to the location of your PDF and select it. The file will open in the PDF to JPEG conversion program. With it open, click Select Folder. The Windows will reappear. Browse to the location where you want to store the new file, and then click the Select Folder button. Finally, select Convert. Your PDF will now be converted to JPEG. Convert to PDF and then to JPEG on Mac The steps to convert your Word Doc to PDF on Mac are the same steps mentioned in the previous section. However, Mac comes with a program called Preview, which can do PDF & JPEG conversion, so you won't need any additional software here. Repeat the steps in the previous section to convert your Word document to a PDF. With your PDF file ready, right-click the file, select Open With from the menu, and select Preview. At the top left of the window, select File. A drop-down menu appears. Here, select Export. A new window appears. Click the arrow next to Format to display a list of options. Select JPEG from the list. After that, select Save. Your PDF will now be converted to JPEG. Don't feel like going through all these steps to convert your Word document to JPEG? For example, if you are delivering a report but realize that you have misspelled a name a dozen times over 30 pages, Find and Replace can correct the error in seconds. We'll show you how to use it. The Find and Replace tool also works with Google Sheets and Google Slides. You can open the Find and Replace tool in Google Documents with the keyboard shortcut Ctrl+H (Windows) or Command+Shift+H (macOS). You can also access it through the Edit menu. Open the Find and Replace dialog box and type the word or phrase you

want to locate in the Search field. Enter the new words in the Replace with field. Select the Replace All button to swap all text in the Find field with the text you entered in the Replace with field. Errors in the document have now been fixed. If you want to replace only some of the instances and not all instances in the document, use the < prev and Next > buttons to find each instance of the word, and then click Replace if necessary. Find and Replace in Google Docs has additional functionality. Here's what you can do the most. Search for numbers and other characters, and even use regular expressions to search for text. For example, find each phrase that ends with option; and then replace it with option!, or whatever you want. Find and Replace is useful for deleting words in bulk. With Google Documents, enter the word or words you want to delete in the Search field and place a space or nothing in the Replace with field, essentially by deleting the words. The Match Case option allows you to search for words with specific uppercase or lowercase letters. For example, you might want to replace the word mom, but only if it's uppercase in your document as a mom. Type Mom in the Search field and enable the Match Case option. No other variation of the word will be affected. If you're in a Google document and want to search for specific text, go to Search using the keyboard shortcut Ctrl+F (Windows) or Command+F (macOS). The Search tool works well to quickly locate text, numbers, and other characters within the document. With Search Open tool, access Find and Replace by selecting the three-point button next to the Search box. Box. Box.
