Take a trip down the memory lane that will make you feel AF nostalgia I recently tore up some pretty dark and some not-so-obscure CDs from my collection on my PC, using both iTunes and the recent Windows Media Player 11 beta. Along the way, I discovered annoying anomalies in both apps in the way they retrieve information from their respective CD information databases. Over the years, I have gradually torn up my CD collection. The current situation, when it comes to retrieving information about music CDs, is considerably better than the early days of CDDb (now Gracenote.) But it's still far from perfect. Now that I have a good setup for broadcasting digital music around the house, I wanted to make music more widely available to other family members. That means moving a lot of the classical music CDs that we have to the hard drive, since my wife Jan is a big fan of classical music. For various reasons, I tear using both iTunes and Windows Media Player, using the respective lossless codec of each player. Both seem to handle CD data differently. Apple's iTunes uses the aforementioned Gracenote database. Microsoft manages its own CD information database. There also seems to be problems in both, in some cases. Take Gorecki's Symphony No. 3, for example. When you insert the CD for the first time, Windows Media Player 11 does not recognize the content. But if you manually tell WMP11 to retrieve the information on the CD, you get a full list.On the other hand, iTunes immediately recognized the CD and correctly identified the tracks and label. However, he could not provide the album cover. When trying to get the album cover manually, it seems that there is none available.Ironically, I added the album cover to iTunes by copying the bitmap stored in the Windows Media Player 11 library. Let's try to get even darker. My wife's aunt, Enid Katahn, is a classical pianist who has released a number of CDs from smaller labels. I ripped off a CD of compositions by Pierre DuBois played by Katahn in both players. Again, iTunes correctly identified the information on the CD, artist and track, but no artwork. WMP11 was completely baffled.When I tried manually to the information about the album, WMP11's service was still unhappy. Then, on a whim, I tried to search for the album information by artist's name. So let's click the Next button and see what we find.Clicking dubois music for piano and pressing forward you get what we need!So why couldn't Windows Media Player Player when was the CD inserted? The inspiring minds would like to know. I had similar results with less obscure classic CDs. For example, let's take a look at Telemann: Suites Concerto in D Major:But when I manually searched the database, the correct information popped up:Again, iTunes found the correct CD, but the album cover was missing.Now let's peek into my checkered musical past. I have some guilty pleasure, and I admit to the whole world that I have a problem. It's embarrassing, I know, but here it is: I have a CD from Emerson, Lake and Palmer's Works Vol. This is definitely a guilty pleasure. Apple's software gets all tracks directly from both CDs (it's a two parter), but I had to add the tag (live) to distinguish the extra live tracks from the studio tracks. (The live tracks were not in the original version of Works Vol. 1. Microsoft manages to handle cd information in a different way:That's right, we don't have song data, but the album cover is correct! Actually, I'm a little unfair here. The Microsoft database correctly recognized CD 1, but included all the song information on both CDs, although I had only copied CD1. When I entered CD2, the screenshot appeared above. I had to manually split the songs that were on CD2 from the CD1 list, which contained all the songs. In fact, I could have been on a list. But the Microsoft database appeared to contain data from an earlier version of Works Vol.1, as the live tracks added were not identified. I had to add them manually. I can certainly understand the difficulties inherent in the type of model recognition required for CD ID correctly, since music CDs do not have metadata information stored on them. But you'd think record publishers would actually provide the correct information to Gracenote or Microsoft... but then, maybe not. The RIAA's curmdgeons probably think this encourages piracy. These are just some of my problems. There was a time when WMP10 ripped off a Mark Knopfler CD (Sailing to Philadelphia) and went on to create five or six different voices, with one or two songs, for each of the different artists who worked with Knopfler.
