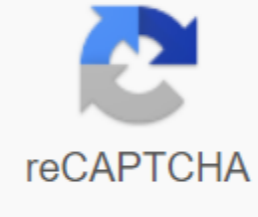

Theft was the most rampant crime committed, with 620 reported cases and 53 arrests. In addition to 155 cases of assault, 351 burglaries were also reported. Car theft was the fourth recorded crime with 108 cases. A total of 57 violent crimes were recorded, including 53 cases of rape and 4 murders. What are Henderson County criminal records? Criminal records in Henderson County are documents containing the criminal history of the information of convicted felons. These recordings include mugshots, parole details, criminal charges, and physical details describing the perpetrator. Henderson County criminal records are collected and maintained by the Texas Department of Public Safety. The Henderson County records are managed by the sheriff's office. The Documentation Division is tasked with distributing these records to interested members of the public. How can I get Henderson County criminal records? Criminal cases in the Henderson County area are managed by the Henderson County Sheriff's Office. Documents can be obtained in person or by U.S. mail from the department's documentation department. The Henderson County Sheriff's Office operates the Henderson County Jail, located at: Henderson County JailAthens, TX 75751. Visitors must register with the sheriff's office to complete an application form or call the prison at (903) 677-6322 to schedule visits. Prisoners are allowed one or two visits a week ranging from 15 minutes to an hour. Henderson County Jail allows a maximum of two adults per visit, and minors must be accompanied by their guardian. Visitors are required to adhere to a dress code that states that disclosure or prominent clothing is not allowed, the length of skirts and shorts must reach the middle, and clothing with prints depicting weapons or drugs is unacceptable and unacceptable. Upon arrival, visitors must provide valid state identification documents before entering. Where and How to Find Henderson County Sheriff's Office is responsible for maintaining the registry of inmates held in the county jail. Interested persons can access the information of prisoners about the online search tool organized by the sheriff's office. Where and How to Get Henderson County Birth RecordsThe County Clerk Division manages birth records in the Henderson County area. The request can only be requested in the birth record at the age of 75 from the date of birth. Requesters are entitled to receive records if they are a family member of a person with names in the record. Other interested parties who are not family members are required to provide legal documents to obtain birth records. Requests can be made in person or by U.S. mail, attached with a valid identity document, to the clerk's office address at:125 N. Prairieville St.Room 101Athens, TX 75751 (903) 675-6140Birth Records can raise a fee of up to \$23 to be received. Accepted payment methods include a cash order, personal checks or a cashier's check. Where and how to get Henderson County Death RecordsHenderson County records are generated and maintained by the county clerk's office. Over the past 25 years, the public has been granted access to death records. Death records may be obtained by suitable candidates, such as relatives of a person with names in the protocol.
