It has been produced twice in the West End and on Broadway, where it received a Tony Award nomination for best play. In 2014, the Lieutenant of Inishmore joined the Daily Telegraph as one of the 15 greatest works ever written. [1] Summary plot Overview The story is set in Ireland in 1993. The Northern Ireland peace process is taking its staggering first steps, and INLA man Mad Padraic is working hard to get the toenails of Belfast drug pusher James when the news comes through that his beloved cat, Wee Thomas, is wrong. So instead of cutting James' right nipple as planned, he returns to Inismore Island. But, when he arrives at the family home, he discovers that Wee Thomas is not sick, but had his mind cornered like toothpaste. Padraic, a man considered too mad for the IRA and hard-trying the patience of his INLA comrades, is intent on revenge, even if it means exterminating his father. Just as he's about to put a bullet in Dad's head, there's an unexpected knock on the door. Scene-by-scene Scene 1 Donny's House. Davey, a pudgy, long-haired teenager, has brought his middle-aged neighbour Donny the body of Donny's cat. Wee Thomas, who has been found lying in the street. The cat has been severely deformed; His brains drop as they examine it. Donny accuses Davey of running over on his mother's bike in Davey categorically denies it. Donny reveals, to Davey's horror, that Wee Thomas did not belong to him, but to his son, Padraic. The cat was his only friend for fifteen years. Davey pleads with Donny not to concern him, as Padraic, a lieutenant in INLA, has an insane violent temper. (He (He thrown out of the IRA for being too crazy.) Donny agrees to keep it a secret, but only if Davey admits to killing the cat. Davey half-heartedly confesses, though only because of Donny's perseverance. Donny then plans to call Padraic, who works in Northern Ireland blowing up chip shops, to tell him that Wee Thomas is ill. Davey doesn't understand the purpose of the call, so Donny explains that he lets his son down easy, planning to tell him later that the cat died. Davey agrees and leaves as Donny begins to phone Padraic. Scene 2 A warehouse in Northern Ireland where Padraic has James, a drug dealer, hung upside down from the ceiling. Padraik has removed two of James' fingernails. James insults Padraic after giving a lecture on the evils of distributing marijuana to good Catholic children (as opposed to selling to Protestant children, which Padraic considers marginally acceptable). Abruptly, Padraic decides to cut one of James' nipples, allowing him to choose which one. Just before he starts cutting, Padraic gets the call from Donny saying Wee Thomas is doing badly from his food. Padraic breaks down in tears and cries that he will be on the first ship back to Inishmore. He then shoots his cell phone to pieces. James suggests that Wee Thomas may have ringworm and suggests ringworm tablets in some cheese as his cat had the same problem a month or two back. When he realizes that James loves his cat, Padraic releases him after extracting a promise not to sell more marijuana, and gives him money for the bus to the hospital. Scene 3 The Road. Davey is tinkering on his bike when his younger sister Mairead shoots him in the cheek with her air rifle for Wee Thomas's pain. Davey tries to explain his innocence and accuses Mairead of being crazy about shooting eyes out of ten cows in an earlier incident. Mairead, who is 16 years old, explains that it was the version of terrorism against the meat industry. He continues to blame Davey for the death of Wee Thomas. In the conversation, it becomes clear that she is in love with Padraic and shares both his political positions and his devotion to cats. Davey explains that Donny has him looking in the countryside for another black cat to replace Wee Thomas. Their argument is interrupted by Christie, a tall, mean man with one eye. He says he's a friend of Padraik's, and he also accuses Davey of killing Wee Thomas. Still, Davey denies that. He also tells Christy that Padraic will be back the next day at noon. Christy leaves, but not before the other accusing Davey of killing the cat deliberately. In response, Destroys Davey's bike. Scene 4 Donny's house. After being able to find a black cat to emulate Wee Thomas, Davey has stolen Sir Roger's Cat Mairead (who is orange). They're trying to paint the cat black with shoe polish. Donny and Davey both agree that the plan is unlikely to work, work, time and choices are running out. The two are drunk, and bond over their shared love of eating shoe polish. They agree that if their plan fails, Padraik will kill them. Scene 5 The Road. Christie and two other men, Brendan and Joey, sit down eating beans. It is revealed that they are members of INLA (a splinter group of the Official IRA) coming to murder Padraic. Joey is depressed and unhappy with the other two for the murder of Wee Thomas, an act necessary to lure Padraic back to Inishmore and get him off guard. The three argue abruptly, and there's a brief Mexican confrontation. They began to wait for Padraik's return, unaware that their conversation had been heard by Mairead. Scene 6 The Docks. It's early in the morning. Padraic descends from the ship to discover Mairead is waiting for him, singing The Patriot Game, an old democratic ballad. He acknowledges and mocks her for her lack of femininity, rejecting her ambitions to join the fight for Ireland's liberation despite her protesting that it is a crack shot. She tries to flirt with him and rejects her advances. He melancholy delivers a message from Donny: that Wee Thomas is over the worst of it. To Padraik's delight in the good news, he kisses her. She grabs him and deepens the kiss. Confused, she begins the long walk back to the city and she once again begins to sing The Patriot Game. Scene 7 Donny's House. Davey and Donny, exhausted and now seriously drunk, decide to call it night. They'll put the finishing touches on the cat the next morning before Padraic arrives. Davey made a cross to mark Wee Thomas' grave. Donny instructs Davey several times to wake him up at 9 a.m., and they go to bed. Scene 8 Donny's house. Noon. Davey has failed to wake Donny in time, and still sleep when Padraic arrives. He finds the grave, flies in a rage, wakes them up and demands to know where the cat is. They show the bait, claiming to have a disease that makes it smell like shoe polish and get all orange. Padraic is not fooled and with rage shoots the cat, blowing it to pieces. He ties up both his father and Davey, and they finally tell him Wee Thomas is dead. He's about to shoot them both to let the cat die in their care when the three INLA agents burst into the room and keep him at gunpoint. The gunmen tie his hands. They say Padraic has angered the group by brutally mutilating a drug dealer under their protection, and also by speaking of the formation of a fragment from their fragment group. It was also discovered that Padraic is responsible for Christy's missing eye. Davey taunts the bound Padraic, causing him to fly in a rage. As he crawls out, he promises he'll come back to kill them. Donny and Davey, still nervous, express relief that they appear to be over when shots fire from the scene. The three agents come running back home, their eyes shot shot from mairead. They shoot outside the house blindly. Padraic and Mairead walk calmly into the house, holding hands. Padraic shoots each of the three factors in turn. Padraic asks her to join him in the fight for a free Ireland, and accepts. Having found love, they are ready to execute Donny and Davey when Christy feebly climbs up and apologizes to Padraic for killing his cat. Padraic, flying in a rage, drags Christy away to the next room to torture him before he dies. Scene 9 Night. The scene is now covered in blood and dismembered body parts. Padraic sits quietly on Christy's horribly mutilated body, holding the body of Wee Thomas, which has been dug up from Donny's yard. Donnie and Davey reluctantly cut up Brendan and Joey's bodies to prevent identification. Mairead enters, wearing an eye-catching dress. She and Padraik discuss their plans for the future, perhaps forming their own team, which Padraik calls wee Thomas's Army. Mairead says she couldn't find her cat, Sir Roger, to say goodbye. Davey remembers with horror that the cat has been killed by Padraic. He retrieves the cat's collar and throws it out the window before the lovers notice. Padraic asks Mairead to marry him. She goes to the next room to wash the blood off her dress, and returns holding Sir Roger's deformed body. He's kissing Padraik. As he relaxes in bliss, he pulls out both his pistols and shoots him in the head. She orders Donny and Davey to clean up, claims the title of Lieutenant of Inismore for herself, and promises to return the next day and investigate what Sir Roger did at home. Mourning their fate. Donny and Davey continue to work when a black cat enters the house. It is, surprisingly, Wee Thomas, who had been out galivanting while a poor stray was accidentally killed in his place. Donny and Davey express shock and anger that four men and two cats are dead for no good reason. They decided to kill Wee Thomas in retaliation.
