Mother Hubbard's Cupboards is recalling about 100 cribs from the Mathew & Lauren collection sold in Canada.The mattress support system can dislodge, resulting in a change in lateral height. The change in lateral height represents a risk of fall for the child. Thus, these cribs do not meet the requirements of the Regulations of Cribs, Cribs and Bassinets in Canada.The company says there are no reports of incidents or injuries. This recall involves Mathew & Lauren collection cribs, identified by model 8700-700. The product remembered is a cot that can be converted into a double bed. The model number can be found on the product packaging and on a label inside the side panel. The cribs, manufactured in Canada, were sold from January 2015 to November 2016.What customers who purchased the recovered product should immediately stop using it and contact Mother Hubbard Cabinets to arrange for the replacement of fasteners for the mattress support system. Bexco Enterprises of Montebello, California, is expanding its previous recall of DaVinci cribs. The new recall adds 6,000 cribs to the 11,700 cribs remembered in July 2015.A metal stand that connects the mattress holder to the crib can break, creating an uneven sleeping surface or gap. If this occurs, a baby may become trapped in the crib, fall or suffer lacerations from the broken metal holder. The company received five additional reports from mattress brackets and descuming, bringing the total to 15. No injuries were reported. The recall includes life-size DaVinci cribs, including the Reagan cradle (model #M2801), emily's cradle (model #M4791), the Jamie crib (model #M7301) and the jenny lind cradle (model manufactured from May 2012 to December 2012.The model number, serial number and date of manufacture are printed on a label affixed to the lower right side panel of the crib. Cradles included in the recall have serial numbers that start with N00, followed by one of the following numbers. The previous recall included the same model numbers, but had different serial numbers. Meanwhile, parents are urged to find an alternative and safe sleeping environment for the child, such as a cot, play yard or child's bed, depending on the child's age. Mattresses made after July 2007 also have a federal label at the foot of the mattress. The mattresses, manufactured in Mexico, were sold exclusively in IKEA stores across the country and online on October www.ikea-usa.com, 2000 to May 2014, for about \$100.Consumers should immediately stop using the mattresses and return them to any IKEA store for a full refund.
