Arthur Wynne's first crossword was originally called a verbal cross and was diamond-shaped. The name was later switched to cross-word, and then, as a result of an accidental typo, the hyphen was dropped and the name became a crossword puzzle. Wynne based his crossword puzzle on a similar but much older game played in ancient Pompeii, which translated from Latin into English called Magic Squares, a player receives a group of words and must arrange them on the grid so that the words are read across and down in the
