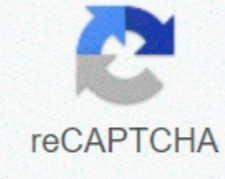

Follow these steps: For safety reasons, remove the spark plug from the mower. Tilt the cut-off straight up to remove the knife below deck. Place the blades securely in the vice. If you are using a metal file, make moves in one direction according to the current blade angle. Always use the correct eye protection when using a metal grinder. Try to keep the existing blade angle in line with the grinder to ensure a smooth and efficient surface. Be sure to remove the same amount of metal from each side of the blade to keep in balance. How to check the balance of the knife It is important that the cutting blade is properly balanced so that it cuts evenly. To check its balance, you can buy a universal mower knife balancer for about \$5. Place the center of the blade on the balancer and check which side – if either – leans towards the table or workstation. The heavier side will have to lodge or ground more to balance the blade. Follow these basic safety tips for lawn mowers to avoid injury: Always wear closed-toe shoes such as sneakers or shoes. Never cut in sandals or flip-flops. Wear protective glasses. Mow only when the grass is dry. Remove dirt such as sticks, stones, cones and toys before mingling. Never tilt the seat. Turn off the cut-off when crossing the sidewalk or driveway. Always turn off the mower before setting the height, cleaning the grass trough, adding gas, or performing other maintenance tasks. Never pull the car back towards you.
