A report by residents and businesses seeking services from Douglas County over the past few weeks has uncovered what can be achieved without leaving their homes, businesses or jobs. Leveraging the combination of the county and our customers' investment in technology, as well as the dedication of our employees, resulted in time savings, realized efficiency and enabled a rapid transition to online and other remote delivery services. Douglas County Board of Commissioners Chairman Roger Partridge said in a press release. Recognizing that there are those who prefer face-to-face transactions and some services that require a visit to county facilities, county Human Services and Philip S. Miller County Administration buildings are open from 8 p.m to 5 p.m. From Monday to Friday, in effect May 4, the release said. With ongoing public safety among our priorities, we will open and appropriately staff these facilities to provide another layer of access to the county services we need, Partridge said in a release. Additionally, starting May 4, paper-paper boxes are available at motor vehicle offices in Lone Tree County, Highlands Ranch and Castle Rock. The boxes will serve customers of the Motor Vehicle and Recording Department, the Office of Veterans Affairs, and the Assessor's Office (including remote appeals). Personally, meetings will be made available for critical services at Clerk and Recorder's Office from May 11. Deadlines will be scheduled when the transaction cannot be completed online, by phone, at the MVExpress kiosk or through the document box. In the coming weeks, meetings with users and passports will begin, as full staff will resume work on site and other services will be restored in time. Due to COVID restrictions, we are not able to provide services personally to persons without a meeting.
