Student study services offer a full range of financial support services designed to help students obtain information on applications and various options for financial support concessions on loans. All students can work on campus through a student work agency. How much is it going to cost? You can find our participation costs shared by graduates and undergraduate degrees online. This is an annual cost and includes tuition fees and fees in addition to housing, room and board, personal expenses, book and supplies assessment costs. What are my net costs after scholarships and financial support? Potential freshman applicants are encouraged to try our net cost calculator, which provides an estimate of scholarships and financial support based on the information you provide. Transfer students are advised to try the transfer network price calculator. Investing in higher education is often a significant financial decision, and most students have to look beyond their own limited resources to support. About 78 percent of our students receive some form of financial support by pooling federal, state and institutional funds. Funding can consist of grants, loans, work research, scholarships and tuition management programs that allow families to pay their fees instead of making one payment in advance. Most of the awards are based on financial need and academic ability. At the Pratt Institute, we understand that you can face unforeseen circumstances. Special circumstances may include unintentional change in income or work, divorce or legal separation, death, transfer of funds from the IRA to the Roth IRA or other circumstances that have changed the overall income level of the family. Refunds are not available until the drop/increase period ends for each semester. Due to a change in the institutional reporting requirements of the Federal Law, starting with fiscal year 2018, (forms you will receive in 2019), we will report in the box the amount of QTRE you have paid over a period of 1 year. Depending on your income (or your family's income if you're dependent), regardless of whether you were considered full-time or half-time, and the amount of qualified education expenses for a year, you may be eligible for a federal education tax credit. The dollar amounts reported on Form 1098T can help you fill out IRS Form 8863 — a form used to calculate education tax credits that a taxpayer can claim as part of your tax return.
