Aspyr makes the game available via the Mac App Store and Steam (which we have linked above). Our recommendation is to go for the Steam version so you can get cross-platform multiplayer - Mac App Store downloaders are relegated to Mac-to-Mac play only through Game Center. BioShock 2 Few latest FPSs have had the impact of the BioShock series. The game hit gold for its detailed action with Rapture, a Randian utopia far below the surface of the ocean, running amuck. A survival horror game, BioShock 2 puts you in the role of a Big Daddy - a genetically altered human encased in a heavily armored diving suit. The rapture is filled with psychotic and dangerous people who have been altered by a substance that can register their genes, give them superhuman powers (and unfortunately, drives them crazy). The game sports player plays action as well, but unlike Borderlands 2 is not available from Steam, so the Mac App Store is a safe bet. BioShock 2 is the sequel to the first BioShock, and if you haven't picked that one up, it's definitely worth your time too, especially at the \$19.99 price. Sure, it's been around for a while, but this game stands up to the test of time: it's a phenomenal FPS that puts you in the role of U.S. Marines and British SAS commandos when traveling to Britain, the Middle East, Azerbaijan, Russia and Ukraine in search of international terrorists who plan to detonate a nuclear warhead. COD4: MW is taking a break from previous COD games by bringing the action to the modern era, instead of focusing on world war, which means that you have of modern weapons to choose from. It also features great multiplayer features with lots of challenges, unlockable benefits at matchmaking to make sure you're paired with players with similar abilities. Team Fortress 2 Free to play - Download now A team-based multiplayer first person shooter available via Steam, Team Fortress 2 is almost six years old and still going strong. The game pits two opposing teams against each other in a variety of modes: Capture the Flag, Control Point, Territorial Control, King of the Hill and more. The play maps range from the ridiculous to the sublime, and you can choose from nine different player classes, some with offensive opportunities (like Scout), some better on defense (like The Heavy), and some best for support (such as the Medic). The game's fun to play not only for its varied gameplay modes and different character classes to master, but also for its cartoon style art. And it used to be you had to pay for TF2, but Valve made it free to play in 2011. (The company makes money through in-app purchases players make to purchase unique equipment and character outfits.) Counter Strike: Source The original Counter Strike took the world by storm when it was introduced as the mod for Valve Software's legendary game Half-Life. Valve redesigned CS as its own independent game using the Source engine (hence the name). What makes it a little different than the rest is that when you're shot, you stay dead until the end of the round – no immediate respawning. Twelve years since its first release, Counter Strike still has a huge following and is still ridiculously popular. Last year, Valve released Counter Strike: Global Offensive (as seen above), so if you're tired of the original, you can immerse yourself in a new game that features updated content from the original, along with new maps, characters and weapons. Special mention: Pathways Into Darkness Before Halo, before Myth, before Marathon, way back in 1993, Bungie Software made a name for itself with Mac players with one of the most innovative first person shooters we've ever seen (and really, we hadn't seen a lot of them, but we knew this one was cool). That game was called Pathways Into Darkness. Man Up Time has resurrected this 20-year masterpiece for modern Mac and they have done it for free. Not freemium - there are no in-app purchases you need to make to continue playing. Free. The game traps you in a mysterious pyramid in the Yucatan that threatens the very survival of the earth. You must descend into their inner most nooks, fighting fearsome monsters to save the world. PID is a game of its time. Its graphics are quaint and primitive, its interface is cumbersome with modern standards, but it stands out a period piece worthy of dignity and enjoy. It's a bit of Mac legend. Millions of players took to their phones to catch animated monsters in Pokemon Go this weekend, but some players undoubtedly got caught off the free game's purchases. With its innovative use of augmented reality technology, zero cost of entering and a tie-in to a storied gaming franchise, the app already has more installs than Tinder and may soon run across Twitter on daily active users, according to data from SimilarWeb.Pokemon Go is just the latest example of a free-to-play or freemium game going viral. But for players who come so into the game they are willing to spend big to get ahead in the game, the game will be far from free. Lowest cost: \$0; maximum cost: ? As with all free-to-play games, the minimum cost of playing Pokeom Go is zero, but the maximum is potentially hundreds of dollars. That's because you can spend real money to buy Poke Coins, an in-game currency that can be used to buy items that will help you capture and develop games of eponymous animated characters. Pokemon Company says the purchase items are for players who want to improve their Pokemon Go experience even more. Some in-game items will cost you \$10 or more, and the largest cache of in-game coins you can buy costs \$100 in actual real US dollars. Someone determined to collect all 151 Pokemon in the game can spend as much or more if they are not willing to walk or drive around the city in search of the animals on their own. Most people who play a freemium game will likely never make an in-app purchase. A study from Swrve, a mobile marketing and research firm, found that in February this year, only 1.9% of mobile players active in a month made an in-app purchase during that month. And once you've made an in-game purchase, it's likely you'll make another one: 56% of payers who bought something in the game within their first 14 days of getting a freemium game went on to make a repeat purchase. That may be one reason why Nintendo shares are surging — the stock closed up 24.52% in Monday trading in Tokyo. One analyst, Mia Nagasaka of Morgan Stanley MUFG Securities estimated that Pokemon Go made between \$3.9 million and \$4.9 million on its first day alone. Give yourself a cooling-off period. Whether you're playing the game from time to time or you've just stayed up all night and run out your smartphone battery twice playing it (no judgment), in the middle of a gaming session probably isn't the best time to make a buying decision with real consequences. Instead, the phone puts down for a few minutes to do something else, such as talking to a loved one, eating a snack or after step 2 below. Actually find rooms in your budget. If you feel tempted to buy Poke Coins or any other item in the game in a freemium game, treat it like you would any other item and add it to your weekly or monthly budget. This way you can get an idea of what you will give up in real life to get these virtual objects. Stick to your budgeted limit. Don't spend more than you've budgeted for, and if you're feeling tempted, force yourself to go back to your budget and find space again. Watch your off game spend. Pokemon Go is unique in that it gets players out and about to find Pokemon in the real world. It's probably a good thing for many players (even if it led to a spate of real robberies); just make sure you don't end up blowing up your gas budget or getting attracted to overspending on companies trying to cash in.
