Ann arbor parking ticket reddit

I usually park in the visitor parking lot and pay, but once a week I have to go to the north campus around 7:30 pm. No permit is \$20, going for \$65.eu know that this mainly affects travelers and students on the north campus. I'm in my 7th year here and parking has gotten exponentially worse in recent years on the north campus as they continue to expand and move more people there, plus the expanding hospital and many hospital staff having to park on the north campus. Personally, I'm glad you're raising rates. There are a lot of people who just park in lots of visitors without paying and a decent amount of people who park in the US lots without permits. As someone who pays for parking since public transportation is not a legitimate option where I live, I hope this frees up some space. That said, the UN seriously needs to fix the problem of campus parking. It is now harder to find a place to park on the North campus than the Center campus in the middle of the day, and will only get worse with the opening of the Robotics building this summer and new SI/CS, NAME and EECS buildings on the horizon, plus the hospital continues to expand.
