



## Mayor's office to combat domestic violence

The data set contains geographic and contact information for New York family justice centers, including: district, name of the facility (always the Center for Family Justice), street address, city, state, postcode, phone number, clock, type of service, latitude, longitude, community council, council district council, census tract 2010, building identification number (BIN), district/block/lot (BBL) and neighborhood area (NTA). Domestic violence and the growing presence of commercial trafficking pose a threat to public safety and quality of life in our community. The statistics paint a bleak picture: domestic violence accounts for almost 30 per cent of Rockford's violent crime on average. In 2016, Illinois ranked eighth in the U.S. in human trafficking, and Rockford came second in the state, behind Chicago. The Rockford Department of Human Services reports that, on average, 25 percent of our homeless as a result of domestic violence. Mayor Tom McNamara spoke at length about these issues during his 2016-17 campaign and took action after his election in April 2017. To learn more about the current environment, to study the best practices of the region and the country and to propose solutions, he commissioned a report on both domestic violence and trafficking (DV/HT). The report was submitted to the city council in October 2017, along with a recommendation to establish a town hall on domestic violence and the prevention of human trafficking. A few weeks later, the city council approved the recommendation, and the search for the person to lead the office began. In January 2018, Jennifer Cacciapaglia was hired as an office manager. She is an experienced lawyer, former member of the city's legal department and founder of the Rockford Alliance Against Sexual Exploitation (RAASE). The Office brings together the work of numerous institutions and organizations throughout the community to collectively address domestic violence and trafficking. The Office has set up a Task Force, which was led by key stakeholders, to shape the office's work. The Task Force has already developed many strategies, including: The Family Peace Center - The Family Peace Center is a multi-million dollar, multi-prophine co-located services for victims of domestic violence. Both public and private partner agencies appoint staff on the basis of full or partial provision of services from one location. Juvenile Response Unit (JVERT) - JVERT is a multidisciplinary team that identifies children from domestic violence and develops ways to restore and safety so that they are not involved in criminal justice, either as a victim or as an offender. Family Violence Response Team DVERT is a nationally recognized intervention model that focuses on identifying and providing coordinated, multidisciplinary responses to high-risk domestic violence. The Teachers' Group - The Teachers' Group is planning an annual Teachers' Broup - The Teachers' Summit, which aims to educate local teachers about domestic violence and human trafficking and provide teachers with tools to implement in their classrooms. VOICES Survivor Support Group-VOICES is a committee of survivors of domestic violence who volunteer their time to celebrate their strength and survival. In November 2001, New Yorkers voted to amend the City Charter to establish a permanent office that would comprehensively address domestic violence. Mayor Michael R. Bloomberg has appointed Yolanda B. Jimenez as the first commissioner to lead the new office, which is one of the few government agencies in the United States focused solely on the issue of domestic violence.100 Gold StreetNew York, NY 10038 Safe and Prosperous Communities Division is a new unit that consolidates HSD security investments.
