Ready to dive? Read on for the top 10 tips for solving crossword puzzles. Page 2 Crosswords are a bit like cobwebs; each response is connected to others nearby, forming a woven network of letters. Jerking on one string of letters affects all the others, too. Most crosswords are naturally divided into several groups of up and down clues, combined with other groups with longer responses. With that in mind, working through the puzzle of one group of columns at a time - as opposed to going through all the clues at once and then all the clues - is a good strategy. Every word you fill out will help solve the other people around it. The tip will always be written in the same part of the speech as the answer. Check out guidelines that require answers ending in S, ED, EST, or ING. Often these endings can be penciled in (but not always). Checking the crossword puzzles of these answers can help you verify that the ending applies. For example, if both across and down the tip is plural for two answers that cross the last letter, chances are that the letter is S. Foreign words will be marked directly, Friend: Fr, = AMI or indirectly, Friend, in France. Abbreviated answers are indicated directly, Whistlestop (Abbr.) = STA or indirectly with the abbreviated word as part of the concept RR stop = STA. These cluing conventions are the accepted norm for American style puzzles. Do you know the names of items with their symbols?. Todd Helmenstine Crosswords are not only fun, but can be a good way to practice spelling unknown words, such as the names of items on the periodic table.
