Below are some additional costs that online students in Iowa should consider. Out-of-state student tuition agreements in online programs: Some schools maintain tuition agreements that reduce the cost of tuition for eligible out-of-state students. Recurring technology costs: Many online programs charge students remotely a technology fee per term or per class. Required Travel: Some programs require campus visits, which involve costs associated with travel and accommodation and boarding. Grade Cost: Some online programs cost more than others. For example, programs that lead to a professional degree, such as nursing or engineering, often include additional fees and higher tuition fees. Qualifying for State Tuition in Iowa Potential students can save money by applying to schools in their state of residence. According to the National Center for Educational Statistics, the average cost of tuition in the state is less than a

third of the average out-of-state tuition price. To qualify for tuition fees in the state, students must prove that they have lived in Iowa for at least one year for a reason other than school. Students can demonstrate residency through Iowa employment records, income tax returns, or a driver's license. Out-of-state online students residing in a state participating in the Midwest Higher Education Pact may be eligible for discounted tuition fees from Iowa institutions. In addition, some schools charge all students online the same tuition fee, regardless of residency. Students should consult their prospective school for detailed information on residency requirements for students online. Several sources of financial aid can help students online in Iowa fund their education. Students can apply for scholarships and scholarships, and special loan repayment programs are available at the state, federal, and institutional levels. Accreditation indicates that a school meets minimum standards related to faculty, curriculum, and academic support. The following sections describe several types of institutional and programmatic accreditation for schools and online schools in Iowa. Regional and national Accreditation Schools may have regional or national accreditation. Regional accreditation is more common and respected than Accreditation. Students attending schools without regional accreditation may not be eligible for federal financial aid and generally cannot transfer credits to regionally accredited institutions. The Higher Learning Commission grants regional accreditation to universities and colleges in Iowa. Specific accreditation of subjects In addition to institutional accreditation, students can search for programs with specific accreditation for each subject. Subject-specific accreditation demonstrates that the program meets the fundamental standards of discipline or profession. Field accreditation bodies include the Accreditation Council for Related Educational Programs and Advisors and the Accreditation Council for Schools and Business Programs. How to Know If Your School or Program Is Accredited You can determine a school's accreditation status by searching the Council for Higher Education Accreditation directories. Most schools also include accreditation information on their website. Schools that do not provide this information online often do not have adequate accreditation. Many students with family and work-related commitments do not enroll in college immediately after graduating from high school. Online learning can help returning students complete their studies.
