

its release, Can't Stop the Feeling! finished as the 49th most popular song of the year on the Billboard Hot 100 in 2017. [77] Europe and Oceania Can't Stop the Feeling! reached the top spot in Belgium (Flanders and Wallonia), Czech Republic, France, Germany, Israel, Scotland, Slovakia, Slovenia,
Sweden, Switzerland, and the top 5 in Australia, Austria, Denmark, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Latvia, Lebanon, the United Kingdom spent four weeks a top of the Euro Digital Songs chart. [78] The song debuted at number three
on the UK Singles Chart, and remained at number 2 for four weeks, [79] the song later reaching the top of the UK Singles Sales Chart and spending two weeks also at the top. [80] The British Official Charts Company named it Timberlake's biggest song in the country with over 1 million units sold,
surpassing Mirror 2013. [7] The song is located in 10th on the UK year-end chart, while becoming the 3rd best-selling song of the year in the region. [81] According to Phonographic Performance Limited, it is the most songs on British radio, TV and in public during 2016, while Timberlake came in fifth. [82]
In March 2017, it has been certified diamond by syndicat National de l'Édition Phonographique[83] and Polish Society of the Phonographic Industry (ZVAP),[84] eleven times platinum by the Australian Recording Industry Association (ARIA),[ARIA],[ARIA],[O 85] septuple platinum by the Swedish
Recording Industry Association (GLF),[86] platinum quintuple by Federazione Industria Musicale Italiana (FIMI),[87] platinum quatruple by the Belgian Entertainment Association (BEA) [88] and triple platinum by the British Phonographic Industry (BPI),[89] and IFPI Denmark,[90] and double platinum by
Recorded Music New Zealand (RMNZ). [91] The first video released, titled First Listen, featured the cast of DreamWorks Animation's Trolls, among them Anna Kendrick, Gwen Stefani, James Corden, Zooey Deschanel, Ron Funches, Caroline Hielt, Aino Jawo, Christopher Mintz-Plasse, and Kunal
Nayyar. [25] A screenshot from the clip shows a scene inspired by Anchors Aweigh. The song's official music video was released on May 16, 2016. Led by director Mark Romanek, the video Can't Stop the Feeling! follow Timberlake on a tour of everyday places like laundry, restaurants, barbershops, and
doughnut shops, with an individual dancing along with a single at each stop. All the reporters finally got together with Timberlake under the highway underpass where they danced together to the song. [92] As Time editor Cady Lang explained, Timberlake danced through what might have been a normal
day: breakfast at the restaurant and grocery shopping. [93] Speaking to Entertainment Weekly, director Mark Romanek described the concept as just an overall feeling of unironis and sincere humanism. It's not trying to be cool or slick or ironic. It's just fun. Most of the time, people are very nice. It's just a
big sugar cake. It makes people smile for four minutes. He declared a short dance between Timberlake and an inflatable waving tube man inspired by Gene Kelly dancing with Jerry the rat at Anchors Aweigh. [94] Bustle writer Amy Mackelden highlighted the scene as the best moment in the video. [95]
Esquire editor Jonathan Evans discussed Timberlake's monochromatic attire, writing the singer nailed it by playing with [white] shades, plus throwing some patterns and textures in the mix. [96] The video received nominations for Best Male Video International at the 2016 MTV Video Music Awards Japan,
[97] for Best Music Video at the 2017 iHeartRadio Music Awards, [41] and for Favorite Music Video at the Nickelodeon Kids' Choice Awards 2017. [46] The music video on YouTube has received over 1.2 billion views May 2020[update]. [98] Live on May 9, 2016, it was announced Timberlake would
perform his song during intervals The final of the Eurovision Song Contest 2016, which took place in Stockholm, Sweden on May 14, 2016. [99] This was the first time in the history of the contest in which a famous artist who had never participated in the contest performed. [100] Timberlake opened the
show singing Rock Your Body, soon moving on to Can't Stop the Feeling!. She joined a group of backup singers/dancers and horn sections for the debut of the televised song. [101] The show did not air in the US due to rights issues. [102] The day before the main show, Timberlake made his first
appearance in front of an audience at an evening rehearsal to perform both songs. [103] On February 26, 2017, Timberlake opened the 89th Academy Awards with a performance of Can't Stop the Feeling!, which included details of R& A; B and the cover of Lovely Day Bill Withers at the end. [104]
Timberlake began the show in the front corridor of the Dolby Theatre, dancing to the stage with his backup dancers. [105] The song was also the closing number of her Super Bowl LII halftime show performance. [106] Using it in other media in June 2016, Billboard named it the fourth most popular
wedding DJ party song in the US. [107] Many fan-made videos followed the release of the video, which included The Memphis Grizzlies, [108] the United States Olympic Committee, [109] Memphis residents, [110] Gilbert, [111] University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee graduates, [108] among others. [112] On May
26, 2016, victoria's secret angels released a video in which they synced with the song. Choreographer Celia Rowlson-Hall and Crishon Landers with the help of film producer Mia Lidofsky make a flash mob dance video on October 2, 2016 in support of Hillary Clinton's presidential campaign, 2016 set to
music Can't Stop the Feeling! - with all the dancers wearing panties referring to Hillary Clinton's [114] They call this show #Pantsuitpower Flashmob for Hillary. [114] The video was covered in news media including The Washington Post, The Guardian, and Vogue, – and garnered more than 2 million views
on Facebook. [114] [115] From New York City, the Pantsuit Power movement then spread to Raleigh, North Carolina on October 23, 2016 with another flash mob. [117] The song was also used for the opening video for the 2017 Western Conservative Conference, featuring Republican politicians from
Colorado. [119] An episode of the television series Speechless featured the song. [120] In Chile, several telenovelas, including El camionero, also performed the song in a live performance. The film version featured on the soundtrack album includes
additional vocals from Anna Kendrick, James Corden, Zooey Deschanel and Gwen Stefani. [121] In June 2016, the American country band Lady A covered the song in langsung di Columbus, Columbus, Rolling Stone's Jon Freeman commented it evoked the loose spirit of a jam band that unwinds at
