Originally published as A web novel on the user-generated new site Shōsetsuka ni Narō, the series has meanwhile been published by Media Factory with an extended story featuring illustrations by Seira Minami. Twenty-two images have been published since 25 June 2019. The series of novels was adapted into the manga series *Aiya Kyū* and published by Media Factory, with seventeen volumes published from 21 November 2020. Both the novel and the Manga series are licensed by One Peace Books and are published in North America starting in September 2015. Adaptation of the 25-episode anime television series *Author Kinema Citrus* aired from January to June 2019. The second season will premiere in 2021 and was created in the DR Movie co-ord. A third season has been announced. The Anime series is licensed in North America by a crunchyroll-funimation partnership. [4] Plot See also: Naofumi Iwatani, a relaxed Japanese youth, was invited into a parallel world along with three other young men from parallel universes to become the world's cardinal heroes and fight interdimensional hordes of monsters called Waves. Each of the heroes was equipped with his own legendary equipment when he was invited. Naofumi accidentally received legendary shield, the only defense equipment, while the other heroes received a sword, spear and bow, a weapon intended for attack. Unlike other heroes fully supported and given to the kingdom by several strong allies, Naofumi's fortunes turn worse after his own companion, who was found to be the princess of the kingdom, betrayed him, stole all his belongings and left him deprived of all help and supplies after falsely accusing him of sexually assaulting her. Mocked by nobility and shunned by everyone from his fellow Heroes to peasants, the now cynical Naofumi is forced to train as a hero alone as he works to make ends meet, until he buys from a slave trader a young tanuki half-man named Raptalia and an egg that hatches into a bird monster he calls Filo, both quickly growing up in adulthood and becoming powerful warriors in his care. As they gain the trust and gratitude of the people little by little with their heroic deeds, Naofumi and his companions work together to carry out their mission as saviors discover the mystery of the Waves and the reason why they are a threat not only to their world, but to other worlds. [9] The television series is produced by Kinema Citrus and directed by Takao Abo,[10] with Keigo Koyanagi handling series, Masahiro Suwa designs characters and Kevin Penkin composes music. [11] The series aired from January 9th to June 26, 2019, on AT-X and other channels. [12] It lasted 25 episodes. [13] The first introductory theme is RISE, performed by MADKID, while the first theme of the ending is Kimi no Namae (きみの名前) performed by Chiai Fujikawa. [14] The second introductory theme is FAITH, performed by MADKID, while the second theme is While I'm Next to You (あたしが隣にいるうちに, Atashi tonari or Iru Uchi ni) performed by Fujikawa. [15] For episode 4, Asami Seto sang an inserted song called Falling Through Starlight as her character Raphalia. [16] Both Crunchyroll and Funimation streamed anime. [17] [18] Crunchyroll streamed the show in both the original Japanese version and the English dub. [19] Funimation began streaming dub on May 1, 2019 [20] Originally intending to broadcast english dub simultaneously with the original Japanese, Crunchyroll announced that there would be a two-week delay in the release of the English version on May 14, the day before episode 19, The Four Cardinal Heroes, was due to be released. [21] Crunchyroll 2019 announced that the series will receive its second and third seasons. [22] The virtual Crunchyroll Expo 2020 announced that the second season will premiere in 2021. Masato Jinbo will replace Takao Abo as director, and other staff members will reprise their roles; Kinema Citrus joins DR Movie for animation production. [24] Kadokawa producer Junichiro Tamura announced that waiting for a third season would not be as long as waiting between the first two seasons. [28] Raphalia was chosen as the best girl for Anime Awards in 2020 [29] Reception and controversy in North America When the anime series began airing in North America, the first episode came under controversy. Several Anime News Network reviewers[30] criticized the show for depicting slavery, raising the issue of apologizing to slavery and framing a false rape charge, with some [who?] claiming it was in poor taste after the Me Too movement. When the show's producer Junichiro Tamura was asked about the controversy, he replied that there was no controversy about the show in Japan, so it's hard to say. In case of any controversy domestically, we will try to resolve all issues with the staff and people involved to bring a better product to our customers next time. [31] Reviews of the following episodes are generally positive. Anime News Network's Theron Martin gave a B rating for the first two episodes, citing the series as looking like it's over its initial troublesome hump and hopefully should slip into a more enjoyable stream of the story. [32] He gave a B+ rating for the third episode, stating that the series seems to be looking to build Naofumi more as a folk hero than the famously brash heroes we're used to seeing in fantasy stories and that the third episode makes the best case yet for the show's possible potential. [33] However, Timothy Donohoo of Comic Book Resources was fiercely critical of anime for having an overpowering protagonist who seemingly never made a mistake and because of socially contentious undertones, taking that the show got its fair share of deserved flak. He further described the show as just another generic isekai show, and a poorly done one, even without what he says are unsavory elements.
