According to the teachings of the Bahai, an individual reaches the maturity age at 15 years when spiritual and moral obligations become binding. The years immediately before this age therefore have a special meaning. This is the time when basic concepts about individual and collective life are formulated in the mind of an adolescent struggling to leave the habits of the books of the Ruhi Institute. The Ruhi Institute runs courses and educational programmes for different age groups from tender ages of 5 and 6 years to adulthood. Below is a description of three of his current efforts, along with a list of materials used in each. It should be noted that the lists will continue to change in the broader sense of experience in the field, and new titles will be added as more and more curriculum elements in development reach the stage where they can be made generally available. The main sequence of courses for 15-year-olds aged 15 and over are the current titles in the ruhi Institute for Youth and Adults series. The books will be used as the main sequence of courses to improve service capacity. The sequence is conceived in three cycles, each of which deals with the spiritual and moral empowerment of the individual from a certain perspective. Books 1 to 7 focus on the exercise of the freedom that individuals enjoy to perform services within the teachings of the Bahai faith and the guidance of their institutions. Book 8 begins a course cycle dedicated to the individual and society. Since its foundation, the Ruhi Institute has attached particular importance to its work with young people between the ages of 12 and 15; In particular, it has sought to understand the dynamics of maintaining small groups in local communities, providing a framework in which young people discuss ideas and have a strong identity. The Institute has found the titles listed below, some of which are developed by other organizations, useful for this purpose. They are divided into two categories and are in the order of the Several other titles are eventually included in the Program of the Institute for the Spiritual Empowerment of Youth. All titles deal with the development of language skills and expressiveness. Some in the first category also deal with mathematical concepts and social issues, while others try to prepare young people to approach the study of physical, social and spiritual reality in a scientific way. Although the moral concepts in the first category materials come from the teachings of the Bahai, they are neither religious in nature nor address topics that are specifically Bahai. Many types of organisations, including academic institutions, will therefore find them useful for their educational programmes with young people. The current titles in this category are: Breezes of Confirmation Wellspring of Joy Habits of an Orderly Mind Glimmerings of Hope Walking the Straight Path Learning About Excellence Thinking About Numbers Observation and Insight The Human Temple Drawing on the Power of the Word In its own work with young people, the Ruhi Institute includes the items in the second category, which deal with the issues of bahai. These topics include those with which young people are most likely to struggle, such as free will and predestination, and the complex relationship between will and knowledge. Currently, the following titles are in this category: Spirit of Faith Power of the Holy Spirit The Spiritual Empowerment Program is offered to young youth in small groups, which are usually formed in a village or neighborhood by an older youth. The Ruhi Institute is developing a series of industry courses, starting with Book 5 in its main sequence, to prepare older adolescents and adults to serve as animators of such groups. As part of the teacher training, the children's courses for spiritual education s. bahai for the children's classes of Baha, starting with class 1 for the ages of 5 or 6, are presented. While people everywhere are anxious for their children to participate in spiritual education courses, experience has shown that the challenge is to train a sufficient number of teachers to meet this demand. The Ruhi Institute develops a series of courses for the training of children's class teachers, which are from the third book of the main series, and the necessary materials for the classes themselves are presented in each book. Especially in the early years of childhood, great importance is attached to the development of spiritual qualities and to those beliefs, habits and which constitute the essential characteristics of a spiritual being.
