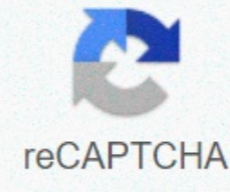

Gerardo medina now

I remember reading about this in the 1980s in the Guinness Book of World Records. I was a kid myself, so this story bothered me. I wasn't shocked; the story filled me with surprises. He showed doctors there that his village's dens were unable to treat a large tumor that was developing in his abdomen. Dr G3rado Lozada was told by Lisa's father that he was having regular courses from the age of three, but they had stopped about 7 1/2 months before the visit. Further investigations into the case were conducted by Dr. Edmundo Skomel, one of Peru's leading doctors-researchers at the time. She discovered that Lisa's menstruation actually started when she was only eight months old, much earlier than her father had originally reported. Skomel also documented the results of an experiment that showed Lisa had the ovaries of a fully mature woman. He concluded that the reason for the early development of his reproductive system must have been from a pituitary hormonal disorder. But Gerardo's father's identity was never identified. For a long time, Gerardo grew up in the Medina family as if he were Lisa's baby brother. Two years after Gerardo was born, American child psychologist Paul Kosack was allowed to speak to Lisa for a while. As stated in the New York Times in 1941, Ms. Kosak said, Lisa is above normal in intelligence, and the baby, who is a boy, is completely normal and physically developed better than the average Syza (Spanish Indian) baby. In 2002, Lisa's name barely scratched the level of media attention again, which she refused to do an interview with Reuters.
