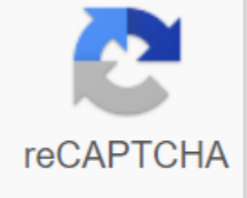

Students attend music and art courses as part of our curriculum, and are also encouraged to participate in extra-curricular activities to further develop their creative talents. In support of the arts within our schools and communities, the district opened the Van Singel Fine Arts Center in 1998, one of the first of its kind in the nation. Curricular and co-curricular opportunities of the visual arts and entertainment include music, choir, visual arts, and Suzuki violin lessons in elementary grades. Intermediate students have art, choir, and starting orchestra available by their fifth-grade school day. In first grade, the curriculum allows students to take first-year choir, orchestra, or band as well as an exploratory visual art course. Choir, orchestra, band and visual arts continue to be available in the seventh and eighth graders of middle school. High school offers an abundance of opportunities for students to grow in the arts, ranging from visual arts (e.g. 2D and 3D Art/Design, Illustration, Sculpture, Ceramics, Drawing/Painting, Audio-Video I/II, Computer Graphics I/II, and Advanced Media), to performing arts (e.g. Women's Chorus, Concert Choir, Vocal Expressions, Theatre Arts I-IV, Marching Band, Jazz Band, and Orchestra). To support the offering of fine arts courses, BCHS offers many art studios, a photographic darkroom, a recording studio, a television studio, a band room, a choir room, a theater, an art gallery, rehearsal rooms and auxiliary rooms. Our students' appreciation of the arts is reflected in the fact that 84% of our high school student body is involved in the fine arts program. Students and professional performances shine on stage at the Van Singel Fine Arts Center more than 50 times a school year. These student productions and activities include young people from the Byron Center Public Schools, Byron Center Christian Schools, and students outside the district. This is the same stage embellished by the likes of the Glenn Miller Orchestra, Dick Van Patten of the Sunshine Boys, Rita Coolidge, The Lettermen, Branford Marsalis and Ed Asner. Hundreds of other students are also on display at a variety of professional shows that attend productions from the Grand Rapids Circle Presents, traveling off-Broadway production labs, and the United State Air Force Band for just a few. However, two months a year, December and May, are set to feature Byron Center K-12 art students in a separate art exhibition.
