Such a hard wave politics continues to sweep around the globe, with many citing fake news spread by an critically critical social media users as a key component of this spike in populism. As a result, a new study has found that 35% of people in the UK believe the Government should draft new rules to suppress social media networks that spread misinformation. Fake news often refers to press stories that confirm false or inaccurate, intentional or otherwise false information. The rise of the often-documented phenomenon of fake news contributed to the success of a new wave of right-wing populism that has rooted in global politics, weaponizing fabricated newsletters to deny negative psychology that can turn into electoral capital. Now, a new report from OC&C Strategy Consultants has found significant generation and political gaps in views regarding fake news. While the report suggests that there is a gap between generations in the UK and US and cross political concerns about fake news and media bias, the left and right of the political spectrum have different assumptions regarding its rise. Most famously, the term was implemented by US President Donald Trump. Although the term came to prominence to describe the widespread lies of his campaign, Trump weaponized the term to discredit the opinions of opponents and critics. This was also part of the reason that those on the left in America are less likely to say that fake news exists than their conservative partners. With Mr. Trump taking power largely based on claims that a media-exclusive liberal elite keeps certain billionaires out of office, only 3% of Americans do not believe in fake news, compared to 17% of leftists. The outlook is very different in the UK, due to the dynamics of national politics today. The right has adopted Trump's mana (only 3% don't believe in fake news), while leftists in the UK are less inclined to believe fake news (6% don't believe it). Illustrating why this might be, a study into the alleged bias of TV news coverage from the Media Reform Alliance and Birkbeck University of London found broadcast news had doubled the airtime for Corbyn's critics than his supporters. Digital journalism Thanks to the rise of this moment of fake news, online journalists face an up-and-down battle to be taken as reliable sources. Last year, research by the Reuters Institute found that 23% of online news was accessed through social media, compared with 32% who had direct access to websites and 25% used search engines, while only 24% the questioner said they believed sites like Facebook and Twitter did enough to separate reality from fiction. According to oc&C research, those asked on both sides of the Atlantic hope social media platforms will do more to take responsibility and fight fake news. When asked what they blame for fake news, the biggest number those asked in the UK said Facebook, followed by users creating fake content. In the United States, creators and Facebook also appear in the top three elements, along with those who share it unsydemdly. When it comes to how to deal with fake news, the UK and US responded disagreeing on the level of governing participation there should be. In the UK, 35% argued that the Government should draft new rules to crack down on social media networks spreading misinformation, while in the US - where many in question actually blame the Government for fake news - 22% said the ultimate responsibility belonged to individual users. In both countries, however, the questioners wanted to say that social media platforms should be more responsible for tackling fake news, while a traditionally honest leader was lower on the agenda. Only 13% in the US and 7% of people questioned in the UK said the media should publicly state how they are factually correct. While the idea of fake news spreading rapidly on social networks is certainly worrying then, this illustrates how it's all too easy to fall into a trap that implies traditional media creates gospel truths, compared to their digital partners. History is littered with mass media corporations spreading misinformation – but there is no immediate potential for reality checks, or forums for mass criticism that the internet offers. Historical problem To this end, a 2017 study from KPMG found that, due to this immediate monitoring, people who obtained information from the internet were much more important consumers of any information they encountered. While 17% said they would trust social media as a source of reporting, 46% much larger expressed concern about the accuracy of the content they encountered through media. Relatively, print newspapers, read by 42% of people under the age of 35 and 60% of older consumers, boast a much higher credit rating of 46% and 25%, respectively. The Murdoch-owned News of the World (now the Sunday edition of the Sun) was notoriously involved in covering up police crime during the Hillsborough stadium disaster in 1989, while Daily Mirror editor Piers Morgan was forced to resign over part of his paper in misleading Iraqi war photographers in 2004. Meanwhile, the Daily Mail has been notorious for such inistry that Wikipedia founder Jimmy Wales recently claimed they had mastered the art of fake news. All three articles were also linked to a phone hacking scandal in 2011, which led to the famous Leveson Inquiry.
