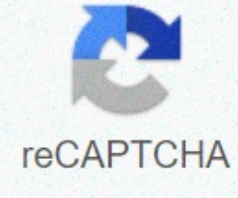

However, the fact that you have three points makes me believe that you took the three most common reviews of finding information, applying math and reading data. They are considered the core of most of today's jobs in the world. The scores for these three assessments are high at 6, 7 and 7. Also, if I had to guess, I'd say you got 5 points for finding the data and 6 for the remaining two. Using data from 2009 to 2009, 5 in Locating Information puts you at the top 21% of all test takers, 6's Reading for Information puts you at the top 24% and 6 in the set of applies maths, putting you at the top 23%.
