And while higher-quality schools are usually accompanied by higher property taxes, homeowners in such districts will eventually pay off at a higher home sale price. How payback sounds great, but how much do we talk about? New research from Realtor.com shows that for entry to the preferred school district 9% of buyers say they would pay between 11% and 20% above the budget. Separately, 17% report that they would pay extra to be close enough for their children to walk to and from school. Realtor.com found that 62% of buyers would pass a home spa if it meant getting into the right school district. 50% would admit easy access to shopping, while 44% would be neglected in the form of a local bonus room. If the house you plan to sell is in a much-coveted school district, do everything in your power to emphasize this fact in all your real estate marketing materials. Many potential buyers are parents of children currently in the school system, so make sure to get the word between neighbors and local friends. If you buy a home, use the search tool to filter by school district, because the boundaries of the district don't always match the city, county, and city lines. After all, you can't assume that your children will be assigned to attend the same school as the kids down the block or even next door. Pinterest Norovirus's campaign is easily shrinkable, but can be difficult to recover. Getty Images A norovirus outbreak closed the entire Colorado school district just before Thanksgiving. Experts say that norovirus is highly contagious and difficult to shake. Advice on how to prevent the disease is to thoroughly wash your hands and stay away from people who are sick. Dozens of schools in western Colorado are finally reopening this week following a suspected norovirus outbreak. On its Facebook page, Mesa County Valley School District 51 assured the community that its school buildings and buses were thoroughly disinfected. Students in elementary school began to get sick around November 14. Then other schools began to fall like dominoes. A week before Thanksgiving, officials quickly shut down all 46 schools in the district to try to reduce the spread of the outbreak among its 22,000 students. This is the time of year when we hear more about norovirus. And the disease can be cruel. If you have norovirus, a very dramatic symptom that people have, there is often a violent vomiting that affects you very suddenly, said Amesh Adalja, MD, spokesperson for the American Society for Infectious Diseases and senior scientist at the Center for Health Security at Johns Hopkins University Baltimore, Maryland. You have nausea, vomiting and diarrhea, and it usually lasts from 24 to 48 hours, he told Healthline. It can be quite frustrating from 24 to 48 hours. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reports that the virus affects millions of people every year. Very young, elderly people and those with other diseases are most vulnerable to severe dehydration. Every year, as many as 71,000 people are hospitalized. Between 500 and 800 die. It is very surprising that norovirus is so highly contagious. And if you are exposed, there is a very high chance that you may be infected even if you are in good health, Adalja said. Experts say that when someone is sick with norovirus, they contain a lot of virus, although you only need to get sick a little. We know that people who have the virus are very much in the stool. We're talking millions of billions of virus particles per gram, said Lee-Ann Jaykus, professor in the Department of Food, Biological Processing and Nutrition Sciences at North Carolina State University. You probably don't need more than 100 particles to get sick, she told Healthline. Jaykus says scientists know that the virus is transmitted from person to person. This happens when an infected person does not wash his hands after using the bathroom. The surfaces they touch may be contaminated. If the infected person is a food processor, they can transmit the virus on to your food. They also know that when an infected person vomits, that surface will be contaminated. But more recently, scientists have learned that norovirus can also be transmitted in the air from repeated vomiting. Many times we call it projectile vomiting, very strong and difficult, literally through the room, Explained Jaykus. Some of these vomit gets aerosols, and it has norovirus in it. To investigate how this is going, Jaykus and a team of researchers actually built a vomiting machine to test how norovirus spreads. The car imitated human vomiting. The team used a surrogate virus that would prevent anyone from falling ill. Then they measured the airborne particles of the virus. The researchers published the findings of their study in 2015 in the journal PLOS One. You can detect it. The numbers are not as big as the stool, but they are, Jaykus added. What happens when the virus becomes an aerosol, people breathe. It enters the mucous membrane, enters the stomach and the process of infection begins. And when it starts to spread through the community, the virus is hard to get rid of. This particular virus is extremely resistant to sanitation and disinfectants, which we use most often during controlled concentration and exposure, Jaykus said. It's also incredibly durable. If I had to add norovirus to in front of me now, it will probably remain capable of causing infection for a month, maybe more,' she added. Jaykus notes that norovirus vaccines are not yet available, although some are being developed. The real way to protect yourself is to wash your hands a lot. If you see someone vomiting, go to the other side. And if you're on a cruise ship, tell someone, she said. The CDC has put together some tips to help you keep norovirus from spreading: Practice good hand washing for at least 20 seconds. Alcohol-based hand sanitizer alone will not do so. Wash fruits and vegetables. Cook seafood thoroughly. If you are sick, do not bother or swing the other ones for at least 2-3 days after you have recovered. First wipe the contaminated surfaces, then disinfect them. Use a chlorine bleaching solution at a concentration between 1,000 and 5,000 ppm (5 to 25 tablespoons of household bleach [5.25 percent] per gallon of water) or another disinfectant registered by the Environmental Protection Agency as effective against norovirus. Wash the laundry thoroughly. H. Then find the name of the school district to get the district's phone number and call the district to confirm. Visit the GreatSchools.org to get the district name, visit the district's website. Many public school districts have interactive school-to-school programs that allow families to enter their home address and get a list of relevant primary, secondary and secondary schools. At least most of them have maps showing the boundaries of the area. It is useful to take this step, because the school district's attendance areas can go from year to year, so information collected from neighbors, brokers and other local sources may not be accurate. In addition, most state education departments have lists of each state district, organized alphabetically by name, or by district number, and often have maps showing the boundaries of each district. Here you can also find district demographics, average test scores, school assessments and other useful information. As the last confirmatory step, call the school district office and ask to speak to an enrollment specialist to help you find the right school for every child in the family. Family.
