The population was 6,092 at the 2010 census. But as some residents return to seasonal camps on the shores of Winthrop's lakes and ponds, Winthrop's population will about double during the summer months. A recreation area located between the lakes, the town includes the villages of Winthrop and East Winthrop and is the heart of the Winthrop Lake region. Winthrop is included in augusta, maine micropolitan New England City and town area. The history of winthrop was part of the Kennebeck purchase awarded by Plymouth Council in New England. First called Ikemachi because of its lakes and ponds, it was settled by Timothy Foster in 1765. On April 26, 1771, Pondtown Plantation was established as Winthrop by the Massachusetts General Court. [5] He was nominated by John Winthrop, the first colonial governor of Massachusetts. [6] Reedfield was founded and incorporated in 1791. The surface of the town is uneven, but it has good land that has deded hay, grain and apples. Winthrop became famous for its orchards and cows. Entering Annabetha Cook Lake from the exit of Marana Cook Lake, John Chandler built a sawmill in 1768 and then added Grist mills [other industries were flying mills, tanneries, blacksmiths, etc.] The Winthrop Woolen & Cotton Manufactory was founded in 1809 and went live in 1814. By 1886, the town had a sawing mill that produced about 200,000 feet of wood each year, two oil cloth factories, a sash and blind plant, a foundry and a machinery factory. The main central railway was opened to the village carrying cargo and tourists. Winthrop and its lakes have developed into summer resorts as they are today. Other than Winthrop Village and East Winthrop, boundaries are not well established and tend to vary from person to person. It encompasses the area around North Annabetha Cook Lake on South Malan Cook Lake. More than 43% of Winthrop's population lives in winthrop village. The north area (Marana Cook) loops around Marana Cook Lake and includes the popular Memorial Drive, often referred to as a drive. The area features excellent public landings and has developed significantly with many summer homes, year-end homes and rental cabins. East Winthrop is located west of Manchester and south of Reedfield and borders most of Lake Cobossite, as well as little cobochycontes, upper and low south. It has another post office and postcode (04343) from the rest of Winthrop, but this only provides mail delivered to the post office of the East Winthrop Post Office. The area offers spectacular views of Cobossy's waters. The south area (Annabesa Cook) borders Monmouth and loops around Lake Annabesa Cook. Popular lakeside attractions in the area include the 65-acre Augusta West Resort[13] and the 25-acre historic Annabesa Cook Farm Bed and Breakfast. [14] The western region (Mount Pisgah) encompasses almost the area from Wilson Pond to Berry Pond. In the southern part of the region is Mount Pisgah. This is a popular fishing spot, as Wilson Pond is rich in warm water species, especially natural populations of bass and dead trees. Geography Winthrop is an industrial and suburban center located about 10 miles west of Maine's capital, Augusta. Nearly 10% of Winthrop's homes are seasonal. The commercial downtown is located between Marana Cook and Annabesa Cook Lake. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the town has a total area of 37.90 square miles (98.16 km2), of which 31.22 square miles (80.86 km2) are on land and 6.68 square miles (17.30 km2) are water. The winthrop is drained by Hoytbrook. The town crosses U.S. National Route 202 and State Lines 11, 41, 100, 133 and 135. It is surrounded by the towns of Manchester to the east, West Gardiner to the south-east, Monmouth to the south, Leeds and Wayne to the west and Reedfield to the north. Winthrop also has Mount Pisgah (pronounced the Hebrew on the summit or observation deck), 807 feet above sea level, and the main fire station watchtower, which was in service from 1949 to 1992, made air patrols outdated. The town's per capita income was \$27,755. 9.2% of the population and 5.0% of families were below the poverty line. Of the total population, 13.8% of those under the age of 18 and 17.8% of those aged 65 and over were living below the poverty line. Winthrop is historically known as a fast-growing suburban town, with a population tripled in the 20th century. Its growth rate has slowed in recent years, with the 2010 census declining for the first time in nearly a century. Winthrop was the largest in kennebec county's population municipality, which was always classified as a town rather than a city. Oakland surpassed Winthrop's population in the 2010 census. In the 2010 census[19] 2010 census, 6,092 people, 2,598 households, and 1,740 households resided in the town [18] population density was 195.3 per square mile (75.5/km2). The average density of one square mile (40.8/km2) was 105.6. The racial composition of the town was 97.6% white, 0.3% black or African American, 0.2% Native American, 0.3% Asian, and 1.4% from two or more races, 1.0% of the population was Hispanic or Latino of any race. There were 2,598 households, of which 28.2% had children under the age of 18, 52.3% were married couples, 10.1% were female household households who did not have a husband present, and 33% were non-families. 26.9% of all households were composed of individuals, and 9.5% lived alone over the age of 65. The average household size was 2.31 and the average family size was 2.76. The population was widespread in the town, with 22.3% of the population under the age of 20, 9% of those aged 20 to 29, 17.1% from 30 to 44%, 34.2% of those aged 45 to 64, and 17.1% of those aged 65 and over. The median age was 46 years old. The female population was 51.6% and the male population was 48.4%. Education Winthrop Public Schools is an independent school district that services about 840 students in grade PK-12. Winthrop's school is dominated by the Winthrop School Board. The group of five members consists of elected representatives from Winthrop. Members serve two-year terms and hold monthly meetings that are open to the public. Winthrop runs three schools: Winthrop Grade(PK-5) 395-student Winthrop Middle School (6-8) 205-student Winthrop High School (9-12) 242-student Winthrop is also home to Monmouth/Winthrop Adult Education. The local government winthrop uses the council manager form of government, where the town council is the main governing body. Winthrop Town Council is made up of seven elected members. The town council appoints and confirms both the town manager and the town's lawyer. The town manager then appoints a finance director and clerk. In addition to these positions, Winthrop has several departments used to provide the necessary services to the town. The framework for the town's government is defined in the Municipal Charter. Political make-up winthrops are known to be politically moderate and consistently vote for both liberals and conservatives in local, state and national offices. In the 2008 presidential election, Barack Obama won 2,006 of the town's votes to John McCain's 1,569,[20], and in the 2004 presidential election, John Kerry received 50% of the town's vote to George W. Bush's 47.4%. In 2009, the town voted in favor of a statewide referendum, overturning a state law allowing same-sex marriage in Maine by a vote of 2,349 to 1,277, but voted in a referendum in 2012 to allow same-sex marriage 53 percent to 47 percent. The camp borders Lake Annabetha Cook and Lower Narrows Pond. The Charles M. Bailey Public Library provides services to Winthrop and the surrounding communities. Founded in 1916, it is located on Bowdoin Street. The library hosts a variety of cultural events, including lectures, film series, and music. The Cobochy Lighthouse is the only active inland sea lighthouse at Maine Moses Bailey House Mount Pisgah, the highest point in Kennebec County, with hiking trails leading to historic fire lookouts and views of Mount Washington in New Hampshire (on a clear day). A view of the islands in the Lake Winthrop region, Cobochy Contese Winthrop Lake is located between Lewiston and Augusta, Maine, in the heart of the Winthrop Lake region, centered on six main bodies of water: Lake Androscoggin, Lake AnnaBesacock Besides Lake Cobochy, Lake Echo, Lake Marana Cook, Parker Pond and Winthrop, Fayette to the north, Reedfield, Mount Vernon, Manchester to the east, Monmouth to the south, and this area includes the towns of Fayette, Reedfield and Mount Vernon.To the west.
