It's a step-by-step self-examination tool that she has built using the open source storytelling platform Twine that allows people to apologize in a way that better understands their intentions to act, how they harm others, and what they can do to make amends in a way that benefits victims. It gives you an opportunity to be honest without being judged and learn how you can not only apologize better, but how you can grow as a person. For example, you'll be asked immediately if you want to hurt someone with your actions. If you agree, you will be shown a list of reasons why, as I was angry, I am jealous or I am not safe. Then you see a message like this: G/O Media can get a CommissionDillon Luxury Throw Dark GreyAt the time, if you say you're worried that you're a bad person, the tool keeps you focused on what's important in a good apology by saying: Here's the thing: the question of whether this makes you a bad person is inappropriate. I know it doesn't feel that way. But the problem with questioning Does this action make me a bad person? make the situation about you, and not about the person you harmed ... I can not say if you are a bad person. I can only tell you that focusing on the person you hurt is an important part of being a good person. As you continue, the tool will guide you through the process of writing an effective, well-meaning apology and trying to see if modifications can or should be made to what you have done. In some cases, this tool will even warn you to keep apologizing now, as it can disrupt the healing process of the victim. There are several types of built-in scripts in the tool, and they all end up with additional resources for violators to consider. Sampat explained to The Verge: I know that it can be really overwhelming to realize that something in your life needs to change, and don't know where to start. I want to make sure that those who use this tool at least had a place to start. That said, Sampat also admitted she was not an expert. Am I part of it? Of course, if you have a nice set of utility knives, you'll also need a decent spinning cutter. A spinning cutter is similar to a utility knife, but it has a spinning round blade when you pull it through the material you want to cut.
