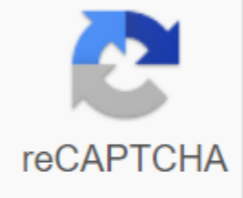

Significantly lower than the main average of 44.5%. This may indicate that the region has a lower level of poverty than the state average. Students of participating schools can purchase meals through the National School Lunch Program. Families with incomes between 130% and 185% of the federal poverty level are eligible for discounted meals. The school may not charge more than 40 cents for a discounted lunch, and may not charge more than 30 cents for a discounted breakfast. Students from families with incomes below 130% of the federal poverty level are eligible for free meals. In 2014, a family would have to eat for free or earn less than \$29,100 per year. Families of four must pay \$44,122 for free meals with an annual income of \$31,005 or a discount.
